### MN Pets

### Red Rover

Small grant. \$250 for lifethreatning illness. Must have a diagnosis. Treatment must be favorable. Income less than \$60,000 yr Check the website for more information



### MN Humane Society

Easy to apply. For illness or injury Up to \$1000, depending on availability. Proof of spay/neuter, owner must be applicant Need proof of income Can take up to 5 days

Not for people who have bred their dogs, for profit funor as a hobby.

### For the Love of Alex

Emergency and life-threatening vet care.

Pays the vet directly. Not for Spay/Neuter or vaccines.

The most extensive list of possible resources. Visit their site



### Care Credit

Credit card for healthcare including vet visits.

Most vets accept. Can pay with no interest for 6 mo.



Local food shelves sometimes have pet food. Call before you visit.

### Banfield Pet Hospital

First visit is free with coupon. Many clinics across the cities.

Wellness plans start as low as \$45 mo -\$85

Plans include vaccinations, office visits, spay and neuter, and flea/tick/heartworm preventatives. Can tailor plan to what you need. Does not cover accidents



There are many other types of resources. If you are looking for something specific, please reach out. We will do our best to try and help.

There is a waiting list to surrender your animals. All shelters are full and rescues have no fosters.

Consider becoming a foster. All food and care is provided for the foster animals. You just need to give them a safe place to sleep. 8-12 hours alone while you work is better than 24hrs alone in a shelter or on the streets.
