

Nathan Hale National Honor Society Chapter Bylaws

Election of officers:

The chapter officers shall be members that are affiliated (or meet affiliation requirements) elected by student members each June. With the approval of the advisor, elections may be carried out however the officers prefer, with general approval from chapter members. This may be through nominations, speeches, ballots, or any other approved fashion. Each officer shall demonstrate that they are able to uphold the four pillars of NHS: leadership, community service, character, and scholarship. Elections shall be held after members have been affiliated for the year.

General officer roles and duties: (these are suggested duties for these four positions, officers set each year and change duties based on positions that are filled that year)

President-

- Runs Meetings
- Plans faculty council meetings
- Runs/organizes induction
- Makes club fair board/represents at club fair*

Vice President-

- Co-runs meetings
- Replaces president when absent
- Outreach communication*
- Makes club fair board/represents at club fair*

Secretary-

- Takes notes at meetings
- Faculty council communications
- Event reminders
- Social media*
- Creates posters and other publicity*

Treasurer-

- Fundraising
- Affiliation fees*
- Managing funds

*These duties shall be delegated to the officer of best fit depending on which positions are filled each year.

Other pre-approved positions include: Vice President of Affiliation (tracks and runs affiliation of members), Vice President of Public Relations (leads social networking efforts), and Officer-at-Large (supports other officers when needed).

If additional positions are required, they must be approved by the advisor and at least two members of the faculty council.

Amendments to these bylaws are allowed at any time and must be approved by all council members, chapter officers, and the advisor before taking effect.
