Care team collaboration and patient engagement greatly improved through the delivery of secure communication channels that will result in greater wellness for our communities






Vision

EpicCare Link vs. Community Connect



EpicCare Link

- Web based tool for community trading partners to support shared care
 - Patient access is based on documented relationships (referring provider, ordering provider, PCP, member of care team, etc.)
 - Users need to be provisioned and signed in as themselves
 - Provides more capability than view only access (orders, referrals, messaging, etc.)

Community Connect

- ✓ Community Connect provides independent providers and healthcare organizations with a unified and integrated patient record to support patient care, while leveraging the shared resources and expertise of an experienced Epic organization, BILH.
- ✓ With the Community Connect program, private physician groups can pay BILH to install Epic in their clinics for full use of the Epic system for their inpatients and ambulatory appointments. All staff within the clinic are granted full access to the system, and all scheduling, clinical, and procedural work is done within Epic. Billing for private clinics stays separate from BILH.

Community Connect – Epic for private clinics

Most Private Practices are EpicCare Link Partners already - but if you have not enrolled, instructions and a link to do so can be found at the end of this presentation. We are meeting today to source interest in the Community Connect program – where our private practice partners would purchase the use of BILH Epic in their clinics, replacing their current electronic health record systems.

Next Steps

- Physician Performance leadership will assist us in sending out a survey so we can collect the total number of interested parties.
- Once we can gauge the number of clinics and specialties interested in BILH Epic, the Epic team will create project plan proposals with potential timelines and circle back with the Physician Performance team.



Instructions for EpicCare Link Access

- Beth Israel Lahey Health Link is a web-based tool that grants community partners access to view detailed clinical information for patients who visit Beth Israel Lahey Health. In addition to providing access to review information in the patient's chart, Beth Israel Lahey Health Link includes electronic referrals, orders (labs, imaging, and procedures), case entry, schedule requests, self-service password resets, and the ability for community sites to manage their own user population.
