
OneBILH Epic Wave 2 Conversion Results from eCW For All Staff

Some procedural results that were scanned into OneBILH Epic from eCW as part of the OneBILH Epic Wave 2 conversion display inaccurate dates on the result report (e.g. Date of Study) due to a

limitation of the historical EHR system. In order to notify staff of the date discrepancy, effective June 2, a red warning text now displays on impacted result reports instructing users to refer to the scanned document as the source of truth.

This warning was also previously added to impacted Wave 1 results. Impacted procedures for Wave 2 are Cardiac Catheterizations, Echoes, Electrocardiograms,

Stress Tests, and Endoscopies.



Removal of Community One MEDITECH Option from Magic Button Integration For All Staff



Beginning June 6, due to a non-repairable issue, the Community One MEDITECH options from the Magic button option will be removed to prevent staff from seeing a mismatch page, which could be misleading.
