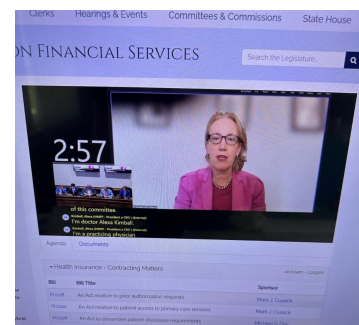

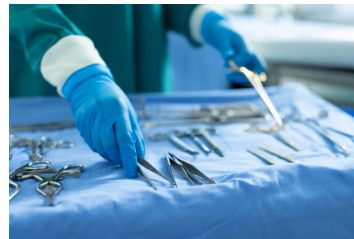

How to Treat Tick Bites

DPH says the rise in Lyme disease cases in Massachusetts is clear – from 2,467 confirmed and probable cases in 2005 to 8,835 cases in 2024 – and notes that the number is probably much higher than what has been captured in surveillance data.

This year is especially bad, [DPH says in this advisory](#), which recommends Doxycycline 200 mg single dose given with food as the best treatment option.

Specialized Outpatient Program for Spanish Speakers

Branches Jamaica Plain, a service of Arbour Hospital, will open a specialized outpatient program for native or primary Spanish speakers on Monday, July 28. The Partial Hospitalization Program (PHP) is an intensive, highly structured, full-time day treatment program that promotes healthy skill development through evidence-based group therapies. Pfizer Recalls Syphilis Drug; Shortages Expected

[DPH has sent out notice](#) warning against expected shortages of the drug Bicillin, following a nationwide recall of the product by its manufacturer, Pfizer. Particulates in the product were identified during visual inspection. The products affected were distributed between December 11, 2023, and June 24, 2025. DPH says it is “monitoring the situation actively with the goal of maintaining sufficient statewide supply for treatment of syphilis, prioritizing pregnant individuals and infants, because injectable long- acting benzathine penicillin G is the only acceptable treatment for syphilis in pregnancy and infants exposed to syphilis.”
