

## Rules, Regulations and Liability Waiver

- 1. Entries are limited to the first 100 total, inclusive of all divisions. Tournament early registration until April 15 is \$120.00 per registrant. After April 15, the entry fee is \$150.00 per registrant. Registration ends April 30, or earlier, if the available 100 slots are filled. The entry fee includes Florida state sales tax, post tournament dinner and gifts for registered participants. The entry fee is non-refundable unless a written request is received at least 30 days prior to the start of the tournament. After that, refunds will be made only if approved by the tournament committee. Additional social tickets may be purchased on the tournament website or at the awards event. Gift bags may be picked up at the Islamorada Dive Center prior to the event or at the Angler House on May 1st during weigh ins.
- 2. The Jeff Leonia Reel & Steel Classic rules shall be strictly adhered to and all decisions of the Rules Committee are absolute and final. A Captain/participants meeting will be held at Angler House in Islamorada and online via FB live on Friday, April 30<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. The tournament website is: <a href="https://www.jeffstourney.com">www.jeffstourney.com</a>. All participants are responsible for knowing the rules, which would include any last minute changes that may be announced during the Captain/participants meeting.
- 3. The Tournament Committee must approve any substitutions of registrants.
- 4. The eligible species are Grouper and/or Hogfish per FWC/Atlantic regulations. Categories include: 1) Scuba, 2) Free Dive, and 3) Rod and Reel.
- 5. This is a "REGISTRANT" tournament. Registrants may only enter only **ONE** of the three categories listed in #4. Awards will be given for first thru third place as listed below:

You do NOT have to weigh one of each species to win any award.

## **Grand Champion**

Will be awarded to the heaviest weight regardless of category entered

**Scoring will be the actual weight of the grouper and/or hogfish weighed.** In the case of a tie, the fish weighed first will be declared the winner. Awards will be given to the first 3 places in each division and category.

## **PRIZE TABLE**

A ticket will be given to each registered participant at weigh ins whether or not they weigh a fish. Tickets will be drawn for an opportunity to select a prize. Every registrant who is present has an equal chance to win!!!

- 6. Unless otherwise stated IGFA rules shall apply throughout the tournament. FWC/Atlantic harvest rules apply. All anglers and boats must possess the proper licenses and/or permits. Per IGFA, electric reels are prohibited. Scuba and free divers: spear must be loaded or propelled by his/her own muscle power. "Powerheads" are not allowed to obtain any eligible species. If it is suspected, the fish shall be inspected by the weigh crew. The shooter shall be disqualified if it is determined the fish was taken with a power head. No boat may approach under power, without permission, within 150 feet of an anchored boat flying a diver's down or Alpha flag. No dive participant may receive assistance with any fish until he/she has one hand on the boat. No transferring of fish or participants between boats is allowed.
- 7. Registrants may leave the dock at a time of your choosing. Other than bait catching, **NO LINES or DIVERS** in the water until 7:00 a.m. All fish must be weighed in the presence of the registrant who harvested it. All fish weighed must be harvested on May 1<sup>st</sup> during the time constraints of the tournament. Weigh-ins begin at 3:00 p.m. The registered harvester must be in line, acknowledged by the tournament official, with the fish they harvested to be weighed, by 5:00 p.m. Fish may be brought to the weigh station by boat or by car and on ice and in a proper container for inspection. All registrants should be aware of traffic conditions to make sure they are in line by 5:00 p.m. There will be no exceptions to the 5:00 p.m. deadline. All fish weighed must be of legal size and must be in fresh, edible, and not mutilated condition. Only one Grouper and one Hogfish may be weighed per registrant.



## Rules, Regulations and Liability Waiver

All fish must be properly gutted, free of dirt and debris and properly iced down for weighing. After they are weighed, they will be returned to the participant. If a fish is determined to be unacceptable by the tournament committee it will disqualify the participant and the fish from the tournament.

- 8. Tournament channel, as needed, will be VHF radio CHANNEL 78.
- 9. Boundaries are as follows: The boundaries are Carysfort (25°13'03"N 80°12'53"W Ocean Reef) to Dry Tortugas (24°37'42.5172"N 82°52'23.4732"W). All fishing other than bait catching must take place within these boundaries.
- 10. SPA Rule. Other than bait catching with the proper permits, no vessel will be allowed to engage in any fishing activity inside of a Special Preservation Area of the National Marine Sanctuary (SPA marked by four yellow balls). If you hook up a fish and in the course of the fight the fish enters a Special Preservation Area you may not pursue it into the SPA with your vessel or your fish will be disqualified. The fish is allowed in the SPA. Your vessel is not.
- 11. There will be no weather days. Captains are ultimately responsible for their crew and should make decisions as to safe sea conditions for their vessel.
- 12. Any protests concerning the tournament must be made in writing by 6:00 p.m. on May 1st. The Tournament Rules Committee may rule immediately or reserve judgment until the end of the tournament. Any matter not specifically covered by these rules shall be decided by the rules committee. The rules committee may disqualify entrants from this tournament and future tournaments. All Decisions of the rules committee are absolute, final and binding on all entrants.
- 13. Officials, committee members, sponsors and all persons connected directly or indirectly with the operation of the Live Like Jeff LLC/ The Jeff Leonia Reel & Steel Classic/Angler's House shall be exempt from any liability for loss, damage, negligence, harm or injury suffered to any participant, entrant, sportfishing vessel, their companions, boat captains, crew members, vessels and equipment, which may occur during this The Jeff Leonia Reel & Steel Classic. All participants, sports fishermen, divers, their companions and boats enter at their own risk, and hereby release, discharge and further agree to indemnify and hold harmless Live Like Jeff LLC/ and their sponsors, advertisers and other participants and any agents, employees, officers, directors. The Jeff Leonia Reel & Steel Classic, contractors and successors of the above mentioned organizations from any and all claims, losses, damages, demands, causes of action, suits and liability of every kind arising out of, connected to, or resulting from the event, including without limitation, any claim for loss, damage or destruction of property, or injury (including death), regardless of whether such loss arises in whole or in part from the negligence of Live Like Jeff LLC/ The Jeff Leonia Reel & Steel Classic/Angler House its officers, employees, agents, sponsors, directors, contractors, or successors for any loss arising out of, connected to, or resulting from this event.
