

PRIVACY POLICY for www.ukremt.org

At the **UKREMT** we want to safeguard and preserve your privacy when you visit our site or communicate electronically with us.

This Privacy Policy explains what happens to any personal data that you provide to us, or that we collect from you.

We do update this Policy from time to time so please do review this Policy regularly.

Information that We Collect

In operating our website and ePCR system we may collect and process the following data about you:

1. Details of your visits to our website and the resources that you access, including, but not limited to, traffic data, location data, weblogs and other communication data.
2. Information that you provide by filling in forms on our website, such as when you registered for information or make a purchase.
3. Information provided to us when you communicate with us for any reason, including registering with the UKREMT as an EMT Registrant this privacy policy is in addition to our registration T&Cs, The EMT Code and our FTP Policy.

Use of Cookies

We may also gather information about your computer for our services and to provide statistical information regarding the use of our website.

Such information will not identify you personally; it is statistical data about our visitors and their use of our site. This statistical data does not identify any personal details whatsoever.

We gather information about your use of our website by using a cookie file. Where used, these cookies are downloaded to your computer automatically. This cookie file is stored on the hard drive of your computer as cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive. They help us to improve our website and the service that we provide to you.

All computers have the ability to decline cookies. Activating the setting on your browser, which enables you to decline the cookies, can do this. Please note that should you choose to decline cookies, you may be unable to access particular parts of our website.

However please note as of 1st October 2017 this website does not use cookies!

Use of Your Information

The information that we collect and store relating to you is primarily used to enable us to provide our services to you. In addition, we may use the information for the following purposes:

1. To provide you with information requested from us, relating to our products or services. To provide information on other products, which we feel, may be of interest to you, where you have consented to receive such information.
2. To meet our contractual commitments to you.
3. To notify you about any changes to our website, such as improvements or service/product changes, that may affect our service.

Data that is provided to us is stored on secure servers.

The transmission of information via the Internet is not completely secure and therefore we cannot guarantee the security of data sent to us electronically and transmission of such data is therefore entirely at your own risk. Where we have given you (or where you have chosen) a password so that you can access certain parts of our site, you are responsible for keeping this password confidential.
