Any class from the AHA standardized Class List is eligible for purchase except those in Cutting, Working Cow, Reined Cow, Hunter Over Fences / Jumper divisions. Classes purchased are subject to approval by Show Management who has final authority. Age splits are available for all AHA classes and championships at Show Management discretion, but remember that both age splits may need to be purchased.

Classes 166-180 are designated as Buy-A-Classes

GENERAL RULES OF THE SHOW

This horse show and every class offered herein, is conducted and judged in accordance with the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book. The official Rule Book of USEF will prevail for this show. Classes not included in the USEF Rule Book will be judged in accordance with the Specifications included herein. Each participant in the show is responsible for knowledge of and is subject to the USEF Rules. The Show Committee shall decide questions not covered by USEF rules and its decisions will be final.

ACCIDENT PREPAREDNESS PLAN: An off-duty Fort Worth EMT is on the show grounds during each session of the show. In addition, a Fort Worth ambulance, if needed, will be summoned by a call to 911. Should the EMT or ambulance be needed, contact the Show Office or the show arena Paddock Manager. The EMT and/or the ambulance will be contacted. The Show Veterinarian can be contacted by the show office. **AN ACCIDENT PREPAREDNESS PLAN WILL BE POSTED IN THE SHOW OFFICE AND AT THE VARIOUS PADDOCKS.**

ACCIDENTS INVOLVING COMPETITORS: A competitor who has been unconscious or concussed is precluded from further competing until evaluated by qualified medical personnel. (See USEF Article 1317).

STATEMENT ON ACCIDENTS/INJURIES

Exhibitors must refrain from interfering with the duties/responsibilities of the Competition's officially designated Qualified Medical Personnel (see USEF GR1211.5 for specification of personnel). Such interference may be deemed by Competition Management to be in violation of USEF GR702.1.d regarding improper or unsportsmanlike conduct.

AHA MEMBERSHIP: Each competitor (this includes at least one recorded owner and all trainers, drivers, riders, halter handlers, coaches and the person(s) signing the entry blank) in an Arabian Horse Association Recognized Arabian Division, at the time of entry into a competition, must submit a copy of a valid AHA membership/competition card, join AHA or pay an AHA single event membership fee per competitor. When an agent signs for the owner at an AHA Recognized Competition, both the owner and agent must be members of AHA or pay the AHA single event membership. Single Event Membership is not acceptable at AHA Regional or National Competitions. Exhibitors in Walk-Trot classes are exempt from AHA Membership requirements at qualifying competitions, but must have an AHA Membership with Competition Card at AHA Regional and National Competitions. Exhibitors in lead line classes or parent/guardians signing for minors are exempt from AHA Membership requirements. (BOD 5/12).

ARENA CONFLICT: Exhibitors who have scheduled classes in two different arenas during the same show session, and who are concerned about missing one of the scheduled classes because of conflict, are requested to notify one of the Paddock Managers of the possible conflict. Paddock Managers of the two Arenas shall communicate the existence of conflict concerns they have received to the other Paddock Manager. Both Paddock Managers shall periodically update each other on the prognosis of the potential conflict. When it becomes evident that a hard conflict exists, the exhibitor must choose which class/arena to participate in. No Arena will be shut down to avoid the conflict, nor will classes be required to wait. Entry fees for classes missed due to this rule will not be reimbursed; however, they may be credited to an added class, added later than the conflict. For **DRESSAGE**, see also page 4.

BUY A CLASS: Cowtown wants to offer the classes that appeal to the broadest segment of exhibitors. **15 classes listed in the Class List as “Buy-A-Classes” are classes not yet designated, and may be purchased at a cost of \$75 through closing date, February 27, 2018. After closing date, the fee will be \$100. Purchaser is still subject to all associated class entry fees.** The purchaser will be announced as the class sponsor and can choose where in the schedule the class will be held. These classes must be requested by the entry deadline **VIA EMAIL---no exceptions---** so that adequate notification of the class additions may be made to other exhibitors. Any class from the AHA standard class list for **Breeding/In-Hand and Pleasure Divisions** [including Sport Horse, Reining, Show Hack, Costume, and Side Saddle] is eligible for purchase. **Hunter Hack and Dressage (Intro-4th)/Western Dressage through Level 2 classes can also be purchased.** Divisions excluded include Working Hunter / Jumpers and any classes that require cows.

Classes purchased are subject to approval by the Show Management who has final authority. Age splits are available for all classes and championships, but remember that both age splits may need to be purchased.

If you are interested in a specific class, YOU MUST EMAIL YOUR REQUEST TO THE SHOW MANAGER at windcrestdc@aol.com with requested location in the schedule to confirm your request can be accommodated.

Calls for classes/check-in with Paddock Master/Tack changes: As a courtesy to our exhibitors, the public address system will be used to make barn calls if possible. However, exhibitors are responsible for seeing that entries reach the gate on time and should not rely solely on the P.A. system. Classes will be called promptly. Check-in is required in the paddock area with the paddock master. Time for tack changes will be at a minimum; the paddock master should be notified of any special requirements and he/she may delay opening the gate for the next class for very brief accommodations.

Promptly Enter Gate When Opened (AR107.1 Effective 12/1/17): When horses are competing collectively, if a first horse does not enter the in-gate ready to participate within one minute from when the class is called into the ring, a warning is issued. a. Exhibitors will then have one additional minute to start the steady stream of horses into the in-gate. b. If no horses have entered the gate at the conclusion of the additional one minute, the gate shall be closed and the class is deemed concluded. c. Once the first horse has entered the in-gate, a steady stream of horses must be maintained. d. Should the steady stream be broken after the two minutes have elapsed, the gate shall be closed and judging will commence. e. A steady stream is defined as a constant flow of horses moving forward through the in-gate with a reasonable and safe distance between them (i.e. two to four horse or horse and buggy lengths in between). f. Show Management in conjunction with the Steward may deviate from this procedure as circumstances warrant.

CANCELLATION OF CLASSES DUE TO EMERGENCIES: In the event that a class, or a series of classes, or all or part of the competition is cancelled due to an accident, storm, or other emergency after the start of the show (defined as initial Move-In Day), no refund of entry fees will be made.

DISCIPLINE—Any act of dishonesty, discourtesy or disobedience to horse show officials/employees on the part of the owner, trainer, groom, rider or spectators associated with any of the preceding may be deemed by Competition Management to be in violation of USEF GR702.1.d regarding improper or unsportsmanlike conduct, and may disqualify the horse and exhibitor from adjudication. Show Management reserves the right to remove a groom, owner, trainer, horse or rider from the show without being liable for compensation or damages.

DOGS: Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Loose dogs will be impounded. NO dogs are allowed in the air-conditioned areas of Watt, John Justin Arena, Brown-Lupton Commercial Exhibit Hall, or Will Rogers Coliseum.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS: On any Driving Map, find your way to U.S. Route 30, west of Interstate 35. Look for University Drive, take the North exit. Continue on University northward to Harley Street. Turn Left onto Harley and then Right into the Will Rogers facility. A map of the facility is included with parking fees on www.culturaldistrictparking.com.

ELECTRICAL SAFETY: *The City of Fort Worth enforces the 1996 National Electrical Code to ensure the public is not exposed to electrical hazards. If extension cords are used in the show grounds, Ground Fault Circuit Interrupter Protection (GFCI) is required. These cords have a test and reset button and have the words “GFCI Protected” on the cord. All 120-volt extension cords shall be three wire grounding type cords. Extension cords may not be placed through doorways. Frayed or damaged cords may not be used.*

ENTRIES: All entries must be made on the official entry blank for this show. A horse may be entered in the name of the registered owner(s) only and must be entered under its full registered name. No horse may be entered on more than one entry form. **All entries must have a Photostat copy of the registration papers.** Entries received without these copies **will not be accepted.** NOTE: Horses will be listed in classes in the owner's name(s) as recorded on the registration papers. If a horse is being leased or purchased on a sales contract, the lessee or new owner may have their name listed as owner if proper documentation is provided to the Show Secretary. **In AOTR classes, leased horses MAY NOT BE SHOWN BY THE LESSEE unless the lessee and lessor are members of the immediate family.** No farm names will be listed unless the farm is the recorded owner of the horse. **No exceptions!** A COMPLETED ENTRY = Completed entry form, payment, horse registration papers, and AHA & USEF competition cards. Incomplete entries will be subject to a post-entry fee. **Copies of current AHA , USEF and USDF (if applicable) cards must also be included with the entry.**

FIRE SAFETY: No flammable materials, such as bunting, tissue paper, crepe paper, etc., are permitted to be used for decorations and all materials used for decorative purposes must be treated with flame-proofing and are subject to the approval of the City of Fort Worth Fire Department. Exhibitors may not operate or place any engine or motor or machinery on the premises or use oils, burning fluids, kerosene, naphtha or gasoline or any other flammable chemical for either mechanical or other purposes or any other agent, such as candles, smoke generators or pyrotechnics without the written consent of the Fire Marshall.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: Any horse that develops a communicable disease must be removed from the show grounds. **By Texas law,** each horse entering the state of Texas from an outside of Texas state must have a CURRENT HEALTH CERTIFICATE, issued within the last forty-five (45) days by a licensed veterinarian. **A NEGATIVE COGGINS ISSUED WITHIN TWELVE (12) MONTHS IS REQUIRED OF ALL HORSES.**

Beginning December 1, 2015, all horses entering the grounds of a Federation- licensed competition must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables.

INDEBTEDNESS TO SHOW: Any exhibitor who fails to settle his or her indebtedness to this show will automatically be reported to AHA, under AHA Handbook Article SUS 102, and to USEF under USEF Rule Book Article GR 913. NSF charge \$50.

INDEMNITY AND RESPONSIBILITY: WARNING, Under Texas Law (Chapter 87, Civil Practice and Remedies Code), an equine professional (the facility owner, operator, competition sponsor, employees or volunteers) is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

IN-HAND RING PROCEDURES—Arabian Scoring System Judging using the In-the-Ring Procedure will be used. **EFFECTIVE April 27, 2016: AR116.6a3 will allow shanking in Arabian Halter classes or competitions only in emergency situations where a horse becomes dangerously unruly and immediate shanking is required in order to regain control of the horse and prevent imminent harm to the horse or others.** In conjunction with AR115.1, with the exception of emergency circumstances where the horse is physically out of control and creating imminent danger to itself or others, from the date of the ruling forward, shanking or the threatening use of a whip (or potentially other objects) as a visual cue while preparing (anywhere on the grounds) or presenting a horse in Arabian Halter classes or competitions must be recognized as intimidating behavior that is disallowed under AR115 and the general provisions of GR839.

JUDGES: This show will be judged according to the single judge system. In the event of illness or failure of a judge or any other official to attend this show or to perform his duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute an official for the one officially designated in the prize list, according to USEF rules.

LUNGING: There will be NO LUNGING IN THE COLISEUM AT ANY TIME. There will be no lunging allowed during the show hours in the warmup/exercise ring outside the Will Rogers Coliseum. This will be reserved for exhibitors in the immediate classes - NO EXCEPTIONS.

MEDICAL WASTES: Needles and other sharp medical waste shall be disposed of in the Sharps Containers which are located at various sites in the alley ways of the barn areas. Competition management may fine any individual up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.

MEDICATION REPORT FORMS: Completed medication report forms shall only be given to the Show Steward. Such forms given to anyone other than the Show Steward are not filed in accordance with USEF rules.

NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED WITH OPEN CHECKS: All entries must be paid in full; **CHECKS WILL BE DEPOSITED UPON RECEIPT.**

NUMBER OF ENTRIES IN A CLASS: The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel a single class having three (3) or fewer entries or to combine or split classes, as they deem necessary. In the event a class is cancelled because of three (3) or fewer entries, any paid class entry fee(s) will be refunded, except as noted earlier under Cancellation of Classes Due to Emergencies.

OPERATION OF MOTORIZED VEHICLES: No roller blades, skateboards, or scooters may be brought to the show—they are not an acceptable mode of transportation around horses at this show. In accordance with GR1301.7: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

PARKING AT WILL ROGERS: The facility is charging a parking fee for automobiles in the facility parking lots. All passes are in-and-out passes; you do not need to repay the fee each time you enter the facility *THAT DAY*. A different fee is charged for trailers depending on where you park them. Fees are collected at facility entrance points when you arrive. THE HORSE SHOW DOES NOT BENEFIT FROM COLLECTED MONIES. You can view parking details and fees at www.culturaldistrictparking.com. You do need to state that you are attending the horse show!

PRIZE LIST CHANGES AND/OR CORRECTIONS: Changes and/or corrections to the Premium, if any, will be posted on the Club's web site, www.legacyarabianhorseclub.com as well as the Facebook page for Legacy Arabian Horse Club.

PROTESTS: A protest must be filed as set forth with USEF.

RESPONSIBILITY: All entries are accepted with the understanding that neither the Legacy Arabian Horse Club of Texas, Inc., the City of Fort Worth nor the Will Rogers Equestrian Center will be responsible for any loss, personal injury or damage to horses exhibited or for any article of any kind or any nature that may be lost or destroyed or in any way damaged. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Show Committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor who will be responsible for any loss, damage, or injury of any person, animal or property occasioned by him or his agents or employees, or by any animal owned or exhibited by him, and shall indemnify the Legacy Arabian Horse Club of Texas, Inc., and the Will Rogers Equestrian Center against any and all legal costs, including attorney fees which may be the result thereof. The submitting of any entry form to the Show Secretary shall constitute an acceptance of the provisions herein set forth.

STALLS: Stalls will be assigned by Show Management. The Show Management reserves the right to remove horses not stabled properly. All horses must have their own stall. **NO REQUESTS FOR ADJOINING STALLS FROM DIFFERENT OWNERS WILL BE HONORED UNLESS MAILED TOGETHER IN THE SAME ENVELOPE.** Exhibitors anticipating a need for large blocs of stalls (generally more than five) are encouraged to contact the Show Manager before arrival (Debbie Cinotto at 817-319-9815) Stalls will be available starting Tuesday, March 14, 2017. Stalls are permanent, approximately 10' X 10', constructed of all metal, floors are asphalt, and all stalls have doors. Early arrivals (Before March 14, 2017) will be charged \$25.00 per day per stall, to be paid in advance. Horses must be removed from the show grounds by 11:59pm, Sunday, March 19, 2017.

SHAVINGS NOTE: Will Rogers Equestrian Center DOES NOT ALLOW shavings to be brought in; all shavings must be purchased at the shavings office. At the time of this writing shavings are \$7.00 per 3.5 cubic ft. bag / \$10.00 per 10 cubic ft. compressed bag.

Stalls will be assigned according to sponsorships and number of horses entered.

USEF MEMBERSHIP: Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

WHEELED TRANSPORTS: No bicycles, roller blades, skateboards, scooters or any similar device may be brought to the show - they are not an acceptable mode of transportation around horses at this show and constitute a safety hazard. **Violators may be denied entry to classes or asked to leave the premises and may be deemed by Competition Management to be in violation of USEF GR702.1d regarding improper or unsportsmanlike conduct.**

WITHDRAWING ENTRIES: Entries may be scratched from the show office prior to February 28, 2017, with a full refund. After that date, withdrawals accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate of inability to show will receive refunds of class entry fees only. **EXCEPTION: A prepaid class entry fee may be credited to a new class entry, for the same horse, if the reschedule is reported to the show office the session BEFORE the originally scheduled class. For Dressage, such a reschedule will incur an additional fee. See Page 2.**

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

Except in equitation, showmanship, Lead-Line, Dressage, & Western Dressage all classes are for purebreds unless specified Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian. EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH. Exhibitors are encouraged to read the USEF rule book, and particularly Chapter AR, for the complete Arabian horse rules.

AHA MEDAL CLASSES. The AHA Medal Class Specifications are now located in the USEF Rulebook. Please refer to the Arabian Division Chapter for rules & class specs.

BREEDING & GELDING IN-HAND CLASSES. Champion and Reserve Championship Classes – first and second place winners from their respective qualifying classes must show back in their Championship classes. **NOTE:** Arabian Champion and Reserve Champions Mares and Stallions (Arabian only) shall be at least 2 years old. Arabian yearling geldings may compete for Champion Gelding.

Arabian Scoring System Judging using the In-the-Ring Procedure will be used.

LEADLINE. Open to riders who are at least two years of age and have not reached their seventh birthday as of December 1, 2017. Leaders must be at least 14 years of age. Safety is of the utmost importance in tack and attire. Saddle must fit rider. Rider's feet must be engaged in the stirrups/irons. Saddles may be equipped with hooded stirrups or breakaway irons. Leading rein **MUST** be attached to a cavesson or a halter placed under or over the bridle. Any rider, regardless of the style of tack and/or attire, is encouraged to use safety helmets, with chinstraps. Boots, long pants and a long sleeve shirt is required of each rider. There shall be only one rider on each horse entered. Stallions are prohibited. To be shown in English, Country, Western, Hunter Pleasure, Show Hack, Mounted Native costume, or Ladies Side Saddle attire. Riders are not allowed to cross-enter into any other class in the show. Rider is exempt from AHA and USEF membership requirements. See also, USEF Sub Chapter AR-28.

WALK-TROT/WALK-JOG CLASSES. Open to riders 10 years old and under. A rider must have never been judged in a class at a recognized or non-recognized competition that required a lope or canter. Stallions are prohibited.

CROSS RAILS WALK-TROT 10 & Under Championship: Scores from class 258a, 258b, and 258c will be used for the Championship Class 258.

DRESSAGE HELMET RULE

DR 120.6: From the time horses are officially admitted to the competition grounds by competition management, anyone mounted on a horse at any time on the competition grounds, including non-competing riders, riders on non-competing horses, mounted participants in exhibition classes and those competing in all classes and tests, including Para-Equestrian tests, must wear protective headgear as defined by this rule and otherwise in compliance with GR801. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place. Protective headgear is defined as a riding helmet which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. The harness must be secured and properly fitted.

DRESSAGE—Intro through Training Level/WD Intro & Basic classes may be held in a 20x40 arena, depending on number of entries. **Classes will be run in accordance with and governed by USEF Rules.** Footing in the dressage main arena and all dressage warm-up arenas is a mixture of sand and dirt. *Note: Each competitor is responsible for supplying management with correct association numbers (USDF, USEF) for horse, owner, rider and trainer, before the day of competition. The scores of competitors who fail to supply correct numbers may not be counted toward national USDF awards.* Entries may be limited due to time constraints of one day. Number of rides per horse may be limited to 3 rides if constraints warrant.

Straight Egyptian Classes: (Classes 15-28)

The Straight Egyptian Classes are open to any horse whose pedigree is **Straight Egyptian Arabian as defined by The Pyramid Society** and must be registered or eligible by pedigree for registration by the *Arabian Horse Registry of America* AND Trace in every line of its pedigree to horses born in Arabia Deserta; AND Trace in every line of its pedigree to a horse which falls within one or more of the following categories: **(a)** owned or bred by Abbas Pasha I or Ali Pasha Sherif; **(b)** used to create and maintain the *Royal Agricultural Society(RAS)/ Egyptian Agricultural Organization (EAO)* breeding programs, with the exclusion of Registan and Sharkasi and their lineal descendants; **(c)** a horse which was a lineal ancestor of a horse described in (a) or (b) above; OR **(d)** other than those excluded above, a horse conceived and born in a private stud program in Egypt and imported directly to the United States and registered by the *Arabian Horse Registry of America* prior to the extension of the EAO's supervision to private Egyptian stud programs as reflected in Volume 4 of the EAO's Stud Book.

If you are unsure, please submit an inquiry to The Pyramid Society (info@pyramidsociety.org) prior to entry in the show. All exhibitors are encouraged to obtain Straight Egyptian certification for their horses through The Pyramid Society as proof of eligibility. These classes will utilize the Arabian Breeding In Hand Scoring System.

Be sure to check the line at the bottom of the entry form to indicate your horse qualifies as a Pyramid Society Straight Egyptian Arabian.

The Pyramid Society Standard of Excellence shall be used in all Straight Egyptian classes as the Standard to which the Judge will refer to in adjudicating the class. A copy of The Pyramid Society Standard of Excellence will be provided to the Judge prior to the start of the show.

Multiple Horses per Handler: Handlers are allowed to exhibit multiple horses per class in all Straight Egyptian classes. Excluded are all halter and Breeding In Hand classes that do not have Straight Egyptian in the title, where a horse must be handled and shown in the entire class by one and the same person. **RUNNER FOR ENTRANCE AT THE TROT:** A runner may be used in all Straight Egyptian classes for the entrance at the Trot. A runner will be classified as an exhibitor. An Exhibitor is any person who holds; walks and/or trots a horse in the competition arena. Every exhibitor is required to sign an entry blank and must be a USEF member or pay a Show Pass Fee. Exhibitors who do not have a current valid USEF card on file in the show office prior to their class will be assessed a \$100 fine and will be disqualified from the class.

The Pyramid Society All American Challenge Cup Awards Program:

Be sure to check the line at the bottom of the entry form to indicate your horse is to be entered in the Pyramid Society All American Challenge Cup Program.

These special member awards will be awarded within the existing 2 and 3 year old Straight Egyptian Arabian Breeding In Hand Classes. There will be no additional entry fee for enrollment in this program. The Straight Egyptian Arabian classes 16, 17, 23, and 24 noted in the prize list held at this 2018 Cowtown Classic are approved qualifying classes for The Pyramid Society All American Challenge Cup program with the Championship Classes to be held at the Egyptian Event in Lexington, Kentucky. For further information concerning this program please contact The Pyramid Society at info@pyramidsociety.org or Carol@pyramidsociety.org. In addition to the Straight Egyptian pedigree qualifications as listed above please note the additional requirements for this class:

**THE PYRAMID SOCIETY ALL AMERICAN CHALLENGE CUP
QUALIFICATIONS, REQUIREMENTS AND AWARDS:**

1. **Horses must be TPS Straight Egyptian two or three year olds at the time of competition.**
2. **Horses eligible for the Challenge Cup Member Award Program must be bred by a North American breeder (US, Canada, Mexico).**
3. **Pyramid Society membership is a requirement of eligibility for receipt of Member Awards.**
 - A. **Supporting membership acceptable for local, Regional/Class A shows, East Coast Championships.**
 - B. **Premium membership is required for participation in All American Challenge Cup Championships in Lexington, Kentucky.**
4. **SE Certificate will be sent to horses who qualify for eligibility in the All American Championships in Lexington, Kentucky.**
5. Horses competing in the All American Challenge Cup Championships will be judged using the comparative system and according to The Pyramid Society Standard of Excellence.
6. The Pyramid Society Humane Standup rules shall be used and enforced in All American Challenge Cup Championships, and strongly encouraged at all qualifying shows.
7. The USEF rules concerning balding/excessive grease/grooming will be enforced at the All American Challenge Cup Championships.
8. In the All American Challenge Cup Championships, emphasis will be on a Humane Standup and Natural Grooming, in accordance with The Pyramid Society's policy to showcase horses in a manner which lets Their natural beauty, intelligence and charisma take center stage.
9. **For the inaugural period of 2018 ANY entry that is shown and judged in approved qualifying classes, and meeting all eligibility requirements as stipulated herein, will be eligible to compete at the All American Challenge Cup Championships in 2018 in Lexington, Kentucky. For a current list of approved qualifying classes at Local/Regional/Class A shows please contact The Pyramid Society at info@pyramidsociety.org.**
10. **For the All American Challenge Cup Championships in 2019 and after, the criteria for Top 5 and higher qualification will apply as follows:
Awards in the Qualifying Classes will be: Champion (Garland), Reserve Champion (Garland) and Top 5 (neck sash). The Top 5 will be awarded as follows:
if fewer than 10 horses in the class: If odd number of entries, 50% of the entries will be awarded, rounded UP. (i.e. 50% of 9 entries = 4.5 - rounded up is 5 horses). 5 horses to be awarded a Champion, Reserve Champion, and 3 Top 5 awards.
If there are an even number of entries, 50% of entries will be awarded.
(i.e. 50% of 6 entries = 3 horses, to be awarded a Champion, Reserve Champion and one Top Five Award)**
11. Qualification will span a two calendar year period for 2 year olds. Age, however, at the time of Championship competition will determine eligibility to show in the Championships. (i.e. a two year old would be eligible to compete the following year as a three-year-old; the three-year-old would not be eligible to compete as a four year old)
12. The All American Challenge Cup Championships will be judged comparatively and award a Champion, a Reserve Champion and Top Ten sashes. Prize money will be awarded to the Top 5 winners as follows: \$5,000 per class with \$2,500 to Champion, \$1,500 to Reserve Champion and \$500 to each Top 5.
