For Western Dressage, the **2022** WDAA tests will be used and can be found on  
www.westerndressageassociation.org and rules are listed in the USEF rulebook  
under the Western Dressage division.

**WDAA Membership** is **required** for exhibitors, owner, lessee, agent, coach, or  
trainer in any Western Dressage class or at any Federation Western Dressage  
Licensed Competition persons must be active members of WDAA or pay a non-  
member fee equal to the price of an annual membership for each competition, \$45  
adult/\$30 Youth.

**All entries must be postmarked by March 5, 2025**, so that ride times can be  
assigned. For any special requests regarding ride times, please call Debbie Cinotto at  
(817) 319-9815. **PLEASE NOTE:** The schedule of classes herein should be viewed  
as tentative; **Ride times are tentative so please double check them once you check

## GENERAL RULES OF THE SHOW

This horse show and every class offered herein, is conducted and judged in accordance with the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book. The official Rule Book of USEF will prevail for this show. Classes not included in the USEF Rule Book will be judged in accordance with the Specifications included herein. Each participant in the show is responsible for knowledge of and is subject to the USEF Rules. The Show Committee shall decide on questions not covered by USEF rules and its decisions will be final.

**ACCIDENT PREPAREDNESS PLAN:** An EMT is on the show grounds during each session of the show. In addition, a Waco ambulance, if needed, will be summoned by a call to 911. Should the EMT or ambulance be needed, contact the Show Office or the show arena Paddock Manager. The EMT and/or the ambulance will be contacted. The Show Veterinarian will be on call. **AN ACCIDENT PREPAREDNESS PLAN WILL BE POSTED IN THE SHOW OFFICE AND AT THE VARIOUS PADDOCKS.**

**ACCIDENTS INVOLVING COMPETITORS:** A competitor who has been unconscious or concussed is precluded from further competing until evaluated by qualified medical personnel. (See USEF Article 1317).

### STATEMENT ON ACCIDENTS/INJURIES

**Exhibitors must refrain from interfering with the duties/responsibilities of the Competition's officially designated Qualified Medical Personnel (see USEF GR1211.5 for specification of personnel). Such interference may be deemed by Competition Management to be in violation of USEF GR702.1.d regarding improper or unsportsmanlike conduct.**

**AHA MEMBERSHIP:** Each competitor (this includes at least one recorded owner and all trainers, drivers, riders, halter handlers, coaches and the person(s) signing the entry blank) in an Arabian Horse Association Recognized Arabian Division, at the time of entry into a competition, must submit a copy of a valid AHA membership/competition card, join AHA or pay an AHA single event membership fee per competitor. When an agent signs for the owner at an AHA Recognized Competition, both the owner and agent must be members of AHA or pay the AHA single event membership. Single Event Membership is not acceptable at AHA Regional or National Competitions. Exhibitors in Walk-Trot classes are exempt from AHA Membership requirements at qualifying competitions but must have an AHA Membership with Competition Card at AHA Regional and National Competitions. Exhibitors in lead line classes or

parent/guardians signing for minors are exempt from AHA Membership requirements. (BOD 5/12).

**USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT: Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above, Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage Competitions, Endurance Rides and Vaulting Competitions: (See GR828.4 of the Federation rules). Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.**

**SAFE SPORT Reminder:** All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about this can be found at [www.usef.org](http://www.usef.org). Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. **ARENA CONFLICT:** Exhibitors who have scheduled classes in two different arenas during the same show session, and who are concerned about missing one of the scheduled classes because of conflict, are requested to notify both of the Paddock Managers of the possible conflict. Paddock Managers of the two Arenas shall communicate the existence of conflict concerns they have received to the other Paddock Manager. Both Paddock Managers shall periodically update each other on the prognosis of the potential conflict. When it becomes evident that a hard conflict exists, the exhibitor must choose which class/arena to participate in. No Arena will be shut down to avoid the conflict, nor will classes be required to wait. Entry fees for

classes missed due to this rule will not be reimbursed; however, they may be credited to an added class, added later than the conflict.

**ARENAS AND WARM-UP AREAS:** All arenas and warm-up areas have sandy loam footing. Arena sizes are:

Divisions excluded include Working Hunter / Jumpers and any classes that require cows. **Classes purchased are subject to approval by the Show Management who has final authority.** Age splits are available for all classes and championships but remember that both age splits may need to be purchased. If there are 3 or more entries in the BAC, the BAC fee will be refunded. Purchaser announced as sponsor.

**If you are interested in a specific class, YOU MUST EMAIL YOUR REQUEST TO THE SHOW SECRETARY at [pliarakos9868@gmail.com](mailto:pliarakos9868@gmail.com) with requested location in the schedule to confirm your request can be accommodated.**

**Calls for classes/check-in with Paddock Master/Tack changes:** As a courtesy to our exhibitors, the public address system will be used to make barn calls if possible. However, exhibitors are responsible for seeing that entries reach the gate on time and should not rely solely on the P.A. system. Classes will be called promptly. Check-in is required in the paddock area with the paddock master. Time for tack changes will be at a minimum; the paddock master should be notified of any special requirements, and he/she may delay opening the gate for the next class for very brief accommodations.

**Promptly Enter Gate When Opened** (AR107.1 Effective 12/1/17): When horses are competing collectively, if a first horse does not enter the in-gate ready to participate within one minute from when the class is called into the ring, a warning is issued. a. Exhibitors will then have one additional minute to start the steady stream of horses into the in-gate. b. If no horses have entered the gate at the conclusion of the additional one minute, the gate shall be closed, and the class is deemed concluded. c. Once the first horse has entered the in-gate, a steady stream of horses must be maintained. d. Should the steady stream be broken after the two minutes have elapsed, the gate shall be closed, and judging will commence. e. A steady stream is defined as a constant flow of horses moving forward through the in-gate with a reasonable and safe distance between them (i.e., two to four horse or horse

and buggy lengths in between). f. Show Management in conjunction with the Steward may deviate from this procedure as circumstances warrant.

**CANCELLATION OF CLASSES DUE TO EMERGENCIES:** In the event that a class, or a series of classes, or all or part of the competition is cancelled due to an accident, storm, or other emergency after the start of the show (defined as initial Move-In Day), no refund of entry fees will be made.

**DISCIPLINE**—Any act of dishonesty, discourtesy, or disobedience to horse show officials/employees on the part of the owner, trainer, groom, rider or spectators associated with any of the preceding may be deemed by Competition Management to be in violation of USEF GR702.1.d regarding improper or unsportsmanlike conduct and may disqualify the horse and exhibitor from adjudication. Show Management reserves the right to remove a groom, owner, trainer, horse, or rider from the show without being liable for compensation or damages. Show management reserves the right to prohibit any person from attending the show or showing a horse in the ring.

**DOGS:** Dogs are **NOT permitted to be loose on competition grounds** and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Loose dogs will be impounded. NO dogs are allowed in the arena areas.

**DRIVING DIRECTIONS:** On any Driving Map, find your way to Interstate 35 South, Exit Valley Mills, go west to Lake Air Drive, turn right. Complex is on corner of Lake Air Drive and Bosque Blvd. Complex can be accessed from either Lake Air or Bosque Blvd.

**ELECTRICAL SAFETY:** *The complex enforces the 1996 National Electrical Code to ensure the public is not exposed to electrical hazards. If extension cords are used in the show grounds, Ground Fault Circuit Interrupter Protection (GFCI) is required. These cords have a test and reset button and have the words "GFCI Protected" on the cord. All 120-volt extension cords shall be three wire grounding type cords. Extension cords may not be placed through doorways. Frayed or damaged cords may not be used.*

**ENTRIES:** All entries must be made on the official entry blank for this show. A horse may be entered in the name of the registered owner(s) only and must be entered under its full registered name. No horse may be entered on more than one entry form. **All entries must have a Photostat copy of the registration papers.** Entries received without these copies **will not be accepted.** NOTE: Horses will be listed in classes in the owner's name(s) as recorded on the registration papers. If a horse is being leased or purchased on a sales contract, the lessee or new owner may have their name listed as owner if proper documentation is provided to the Show Secretary. **In AOTR classes, leased horses MAY NOT BE SHOWN BY THE LESSEE unless the lessee and lessor are members of the immediate family.** No farm names will be listed unless the farm is the recorded owner of the horse. **No**



**exceptions!** A COMPLETED ENTRY = Completed entry form, payment, horse registration papers, and AHA competition cards. Incomplete entries will be subject to a post-entry fee. **Copies of current AHA cards must also be included with the entry.**

**FIRE SAFETY:** No flammable materials, such as bunting, tissue paper, crepe paper, etc., are permitted to be used for decorations and all materials used for decorative purposes must be treated with flame-proofing and are subject to the approval of the City of Waco Fire Department. Exhibitors may not operate or place any engine or motor or machinery on the premises or use oils, burning fluids, kerosene, naphtha or gasoline or any other flammable chemical for either mechanical or other purposes or any other agent, such as candles, smoke generators or pyrotechnics without the written consent of the Fire Marshall.

**HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:** Any horse that develops a communicable disease must be removed from the show grounds. **By Texas law**, each horse entering the state of Texas from an outside of Texas state must have a CURRENT HEALTH CERTIFICATE, issued within the last forty-five (45) days by a licensed veterinarian. **A NEGATIVE COGGINS ISSUED WITHIN TWELVE (12) MONTHS IS REQUIRED OF ALL HORSES.**

**Beginning December 1, 2015, all horses entering the grounds of a Federation-licensed competition must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables.**

**INDEBTEDNESS TO SHOW:** Any exhibitor who fails to settle his or her indebtedness to this show will automatically be reported to AHA, under AHA Handbook Article SUS 102, and to USEF under USEF Rule Book Article GR 913. NSF charge \$50.

**INDEMNITY AND RESPONSIBILITY: WARNING:**

UNDER TEXAS LAW (CHAPTER 87 ([Liability Arising From Farm Animal Activities or Livestock Shows](#)), CIVIL PRACTICE AND REMEDIES CODE), A FARM ANIMAL PROFESSIONAL IS NOT LIABLE FOR AN INJURY TO OR THE DEATH OF A PARTICIPANT IN FARM ANIMAL ACTIVITIES RESULTING FROM THE INHERENT RISKS OF FARM ANIMAL ACTIVITIES.

**IN-HAND RING PROCEDURES**—Comparative judging using the In-the-Ring Procedure will be used. **EFFECTIVE April 27, 2016: AR116.6a3 will allow shanking in Arabian Halter classes or competitions only in emergency situations where a horse becomes dangerously unruly and immediate shanking is required in order to regain control of the horse and prevent imminent harm to the horse or others.** In conjunction with AR115.1, with the exception of emergency

circumstances where the horse is physically out of control and creating imminent danger to itself or others, from the date of the ruling forward, shanking or the threatening use of a whip (or potentially other objects) as a visual cue while preparing (anywhere on the grounds) or presenting a horse in Arabian Halter classes or competitions must be recognized as intimidating behavior that is disallowed under AR115 and the general provisions of GR839.

**JUDGES:** This show will be judged according to the single judge system. In the event of illness or failure of a judge or any other official to attend this show or to perform his duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute an official for the one officially designated in the prize list, according to USEF rules.

**LUNGING:** There will be NO LUNGING IN THE INDOOR ARENA AT ANY TIME. There will be no lunging allowed during the show hours in the warmup/exercise ring outside the INDOOR ARENA. This will be reserved for exhibitors in the immediate classes - NO EXCEPTIONS.

**MEDICAL WASTES:** Needles and other sharp medical waste shall be disposed of in the Sharps Containers which are located at various sites in the alley ways of the barn areas. Competition management may fine any individual up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.

**MEDICATION REPORT FORMS:** Completed medication report forms shall only be filled out online.

**NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED WITH OPEN CHECKS:** All entries must be paid in full; **CHECKS WILL BE DEPOSITED UPON RECEIPT.**

**NUMBER OF ENTRIES IN A CLASS: The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel a single class having three (3) or fewer entries or to combine or split classes, as they deem necessary.** In the event a class is cancelled because of three (3) or fewer entries, any paid class entry fee(s) will be refunded, except as noted earlier under Cancellation of Classes Due to Emergencies.

**OPERATION OF MOTORIZED VEHICLES:** No roller blades, skateboards, or scooters may be brought to the show—they are not an acceptable mode of transportation around horses at this show. In accordance with GR1301.7: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that

operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. No bicycles are to be ridden in the barns.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to Segway's, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

**PARKING:** There is ample free parking around the complex.

**POST ENTRIES:** Post entries will be accepted with a post entry fee of \$30 per horse if done after closing date of 3/5/2025.

**PRIZE LIST CHANGES AND/OR CORRECTIONS:** Changes and/or corrections to the Premium, if any, will be posted on the Club's web site, [www.legacyarabianhorseclub.com](http://www.legacyarabianhorseclub.com) as well as the Facebook page for Legacy Arabian Horse Club.

**PROTESTS:** A protest must be filed as set forth with USEF.

**RESPONSIBILITY:** All entries are accepted with the understanding that neither the Legacy Arabian Horse Club of Texas, Inc., North Texas Arabian Horse Club, or Extraco Events Center will be responsible for any loss, personal injury or damage to horses exhibited or for any article of any kind or any nature that may be lost or destroyed or in any way damaged. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Show Committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor who will be responsible for any loss, damage, or injury of any person, animal or property occasioned by him or his agents or employees, or by any animal owned or exhibited by him, and shall indemnify the Legacy Arabian Horse Club of Texas, Inc., North Texas Arabian Horse Club or Extraco Events Center against any and all legal costs, including attorney fees which may be the result thereof. The submitting of any entry form to the Show Secretary shall constitute an acceptance of the provisions herein set forth.

**STALLS:** Stalls will be assigned by Show Management. The Show Management reserves the right to remove horses not stabled properly. All horses must have their own stall. **NO REQUESTS FOR ADJOINING STALLS FROM DIFFERENT OWNERS WILL BE HONORED UNLESS MAILED TOGETHER IN THE SAME ENVELOPE.** Exhibitors anticipating a need for large blocks of stalls

(generally more than five) are encouraged to contact the Assistant Manager before arrival (Edythe Snowden at 830-237-0966)

Stalls will be available starting Wednesday, March 19, 2025. Stalls are permanent, approximately 10' X 10', ½ wall of plywood and horizontal bars, floors are dirt, and all stalls have doors. No Early arrivals (Before Wednesday, March 19, 2025). Horses must be removed from the show grounds by 11:59 pm, Sunday, March 23, 2025.

**SHAVINGS NOTE: Extraco Events Center DOES NOT ALLOW shavings to be brought in; all shavings may be preordered on your entry form \$12/bag.**

**Stalls will be assigned according to sponsorships and the number of horses entered.**

**WHEELED TRANSPORTS:** No bicycles, roller blades, skateboards, scooters or any similar device may be brought to the show - they are not an acceptable mode of transportation around horses at this show and constitute a safety hazard. **Violators may be denied entry to classes or asked to leave the premises and may be deemed by Competition Management to be in violation of USEF GR702.1d regarding improper or unsportsmanlike conduct.**

**WITHDRAWING ENTRIES:** Entries may be scratched from the show office prior to March 5, 2025, with a full refund. After that date, withdrawals accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate of inability to show will receive refunds of class entry fees only. **EXCEPTION: A prepaid class entry fee may be credited to a new class entry, for the same horse, if the reschedule is reported to the show office the session BEFORE the originally scheduled class.**

## CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

*Except in equitation, showmanship, Lead-Line, Dressage, & Western Dressage all classes are for purebreds unless specified Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian (HA/AA).* **EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.** Exhibitors are encouraged to read the USEF rule book, and particularly Chapter AR, for the complete Arabian horse rules.

**AHA MEDAL CLASSES.** The AHA Medal Class Specifications are now located in the USEF Rulebook. Please refer to the Arabian Division Chapter for rules & class specs.

**BREEDING & GELDING IN-HAND CLASSES.** Arabian Comparative Judging using the In-the-Ring Procedure will be used.

**The number of rides per horse may be limited to 3 rides if constraints warrant.**

**LEADLINE.** Open to riders who are at least two years of age and have not reached their seventh birthday as of December 1, 2024. Leaders must be at least 14 years of age. Safety is of the utmost importance in tack and attire. Saddle must fit rider. Rider's feet must be engaged in the stirrups/irons. Saddles may be equipped with hooded stirrups or breakaway irons. Leading rein **MUST** be attached to a cavesson, or a halter placed under or over the bridle. Any rider, regardless of the style of tack and/or attire, is encouraged to use safety helmets, with chinstraps. Boots, long pants and a long sleeve shirt is required of each rider. There shall be only one rider on each horse entered. Stallions are prohibited. To be shown in English, Country, Western, Hunter Pleasure, Show Hack, Mounted Native costume, or Ladies Side Saddle attire. Riders are not allowed to cross-enter any other class in the show. Rider is exempt from AHA and USEF membership requirements. See also, USEF Sub Chapter AR-28.

**10 & Under WALK-TROT/WALK-JOG CLASSES.** Open to riders 10 years old and under. A rider must have never been judged in a class at a recognized or non-recognized competition that required a lope or canter. Stallions are prohibited.

**DRESSAGE**—Intro through Training Level & WD Intro & Basic classes may be held in a 20x40 arena, depending on number of entries. **Classes will be run in accordance with and governed by USEF Rules.** Footing in the dressage arena and all dressage warm-up arenas is a mixture of sand and dirt. **2023 USEF Tests and 2022 WDAA tests will be used.**

**Musical Freestyle Exhibition class – Dressage or Western Dressage, exhibitor must supply music.**

#### **DRESSAGE HELMET RULE**

DR 120.6: From the time horses are officially admitted to the competition grounds by competition management, anyone mounted on a horse at any time on the competition grounds, including non-competing riders, riders on non-competing horses, mounted participants in exhibition classes and those competing in all classes and tests, including Para-Equestrian tests, must wear protective headgear as defined by this rule and otherwise in compliance with GR801. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place. Protective headgear is defined as a riding helmet which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. The harness must be secured and properly fitted.

*Note: Each competitor is responsible for supplying management with correct association numbers (USDF, USEF) for horse, owner, rider and trainer, before the day of the competition. The scores of competitors who fail to supply correct numbers may not be counted toward national USDF awards.*

**Entries may be limited due to time constraints of one day.**

**WESTERN DRESSAGE SUITABILITY** – WD132, horse must not have shown in a WD test in Level 1 or above and/or shown in Western Dressage Hack.

**Western Dressage Hack** – WD 137, once a horse has shown in Western Dressage Hack, horse cannot subsequently be shown in a Western Dressage Suitability.

**AHA ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION**

**This document waives very important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.**

In consideration for AHA permitting me to participate in this Competition, and by signing the entry blank, I agree as follows:

**I AGREE** that I choose to participate voluntarily in this Competition, as a rider, driver, handler, leasee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. **I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.**

## WHAT IS WESTERN DRESSAGE?

It was only natural that at some point East would meet West, English would meet Western, and Classical dressage would meet the spirit of the Western horse. When that day arrived, Western Dressage was born.

The Western Dressage discipline is a melding of training methods. Classical dressage brings the techniques of master European horsemen, techniques that are hundreds of years old, and principles that encourage cadence, balance, and carriage. It is technical and it is precise—a rigorous discipline for horse and rider. It is also an art. Western horsemanship has been practiced on the ranches of the American West since the 1700s and even earlier through the traditions of the Spanish vaqueros. The subsequent advances in Western horsemanship created by the Dorrance brothers and practiced by a new generation of horsemen and women opened the door to the mind of the horse, encouraging patience and understanding. The concept of “lightness” and subtle cues grew from its acceptance. They found that the result was good for both horse and rider.

## WHAT IS WDAA?

The Western Dressage Association of America is an Educational Not for Profit with a 501c3 status. Our primary focus is on education about and the promotion of Western Dressage.
