Community Support - Health

Indigenous Australian children face significant dental health challenges, with rates of tooth decay 1.5–2.5 times higher than the national average

Dental – A collaboration between UWA dental and Hancock Prospecting, Dental students volunteered to conduct oral health program to primary age students with 6 monthly visits to Menzies, Leonora, Jigalong, Yandeyarra, Waralong

Program included a Dental pack for each student, how to brush properly and impact of sugary foods



Community Support - Health



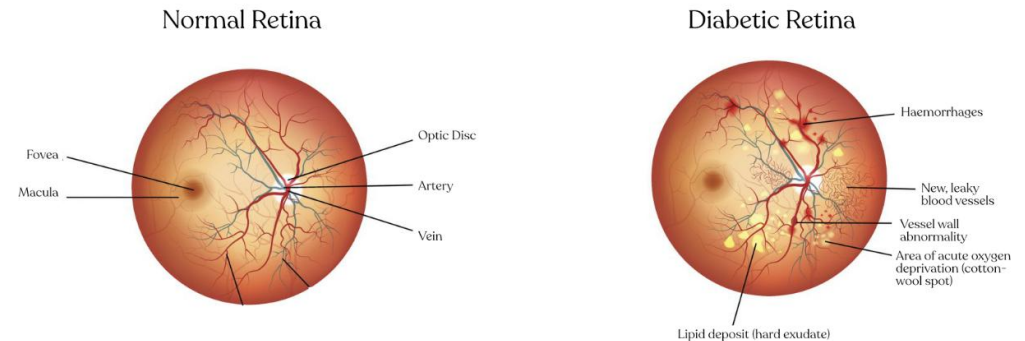
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Eye – Retinal eye scans for diabetes, often referred to as diabetic retinopathy screening, are a critical, non-invasive service offered in Western Australia to detect early signs of vision damage.

These scans use high-resolution digital cameras to photograph the back of the eye, identifying changes in blood vessels caused by diabetes

Community Support - Health



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AMRRIC – (Animal Management in Rural and Remote Indigenous Communities), Operates on-the-ground veterinary projects in remote outback and Indigenous communities. They partner with local stakeholders to bring surgical desexing and parasite control to areas without a local vet

Breakfast Program – 1 in 5 kids miss out on breakfast, Foodbank program to support schools in the Goldfields



Community Support - Health



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EON Foundation Thriving Communities - EON partners directly with remote schools and Aboriginal communities across the **Kimberley, Pilbara, and Mid-West** to build sustainable bush-tucker, fruit, and vegetable gardens.



Community Support - Education



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Madalah – not-for-profit that provides secondary and tertiary education scholarships for indigenous kids in WA, NT and soon to be Qld.

Administrates the scholarship, staff support in Bentley, academic and non-academic schools including if the student prefers to stay remote including John Paul College in Kalgoorlie.

Clontarf - Clontarf Foundation exists to improve the education, discipline, life skills, self-esteem and employment prospects of young Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander men and by doing so equips them to participate more meaningfully in society.



Community Support - Education

Ethan Indigenous – Laptops for Indigenous Youth, Refurbished laptops program for indigenous youth that don't have access

Stephen Michael Foundation – Sports based program established in 2017 to support all young people in WA.

Waalitj Foundation – partner with schools, families and community to improve attendance (Deadly Sista Girlz, EEAI Wiluna)

Scaling Up Success in Remote Schools Program - aims to close the gap in reading and writing

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Niyaparli Flora Book – Jirntalpa Karnti (Niyaparli Flora) is a collaborative project between the Niyaparli people and Roy Hill.

The project, at its heart, is an important ethnobotanical cultural heritage study documenting important cultural knowledge and showcasing much of the diverse flora that exists on Niyaparli Country in the Eastern Pilbara region of Western Australia

Community Support - Governance

Most PBC or Corporation board members lack the skills and knowledge

Governance training for directors – Australian Institute of Company Directors provide education for Indigenous Organisations

ORIC – Provide a range of training to board members to build corporate governance knowledge, skills, efficiency and accountability.

Community Support - Considerations

Consultation – Understanding what the Traditional Owners need and desire

Duplication of services – Many assistance programs exist and are operated by different agencies or groups

Lasting impact – mining is a finite resource, and impact should be well after mining ceases

Celebration – Recognise important dates including Reconciliation week, NAIDOC week, Native title determination anniversary, Indigenous Business month



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
