It is for sport models that must look at least somewhat like a full-scale airplane and have a cabin with windshield or an open cockpit. Any number of wings are OK, in fact, the more the merrier! Also, must have a two wheeled landing gear mounted in the normal position. Power can be anything, glow, diesel, Jetex, CO2, or ignition. NO rubber or electric.

So, build a Dakota, a Sioux, or a Tom Boy, or whatever you want. Check out Outer Zone for Vic Smeed designs (he designed the Tom Boy), Vic did loads of sport models.

Flight scoring: You are allowed three flights Each flight score is the sum of Duration divided by Eng. Run time. Your contest official score is the best of three
