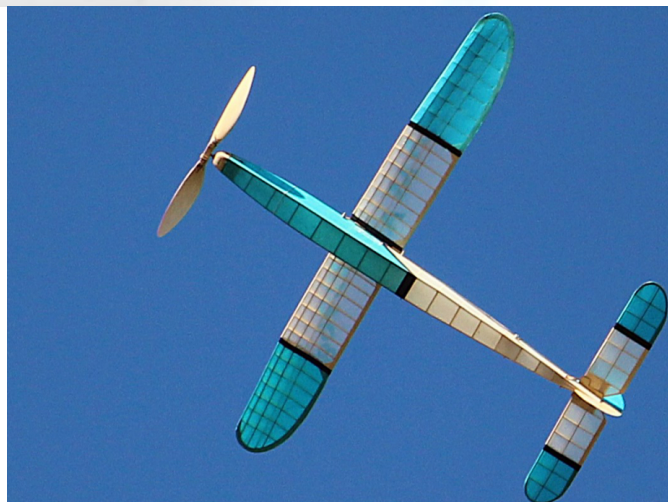

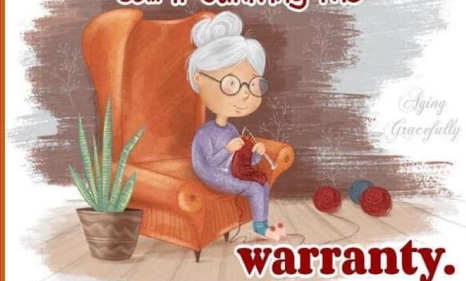
Come Fly Old Time Rubber Models With Us!

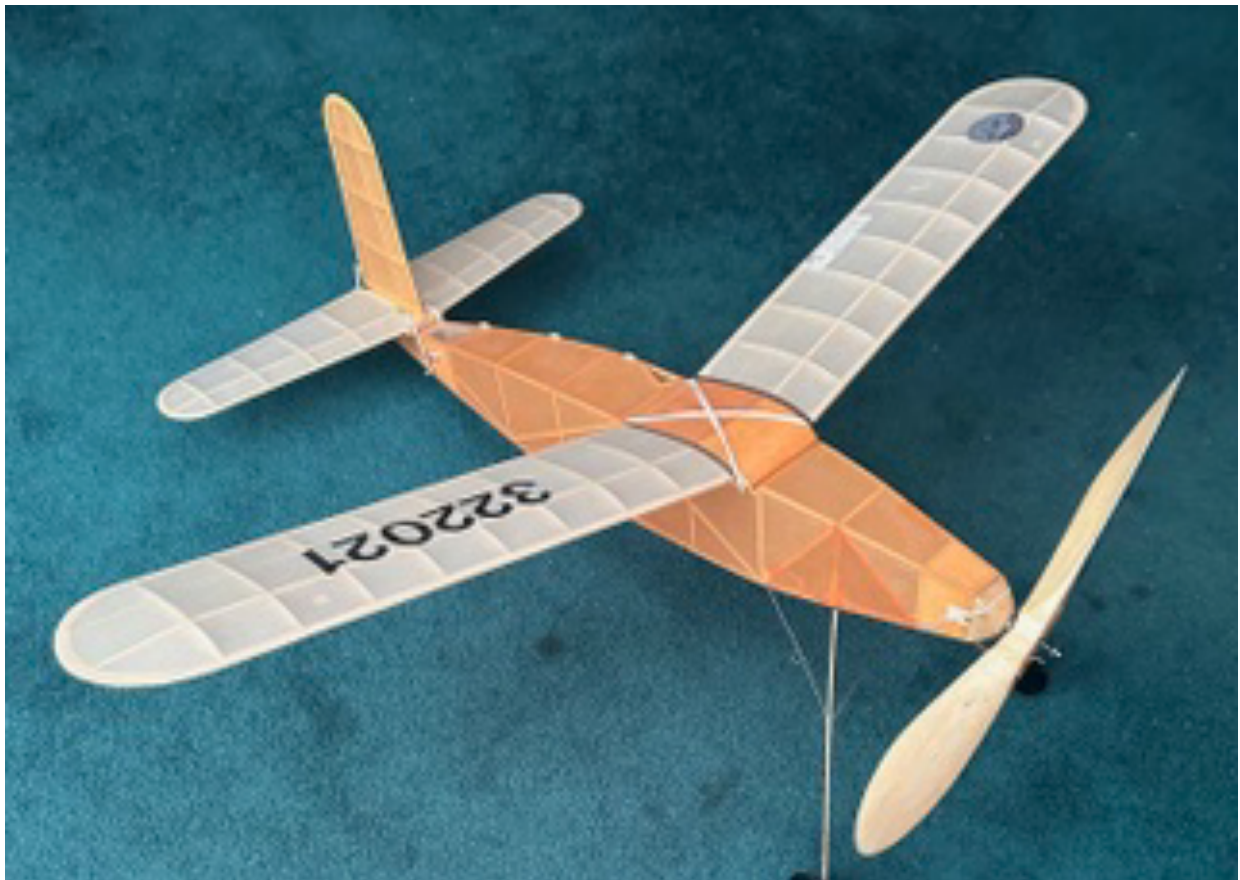
I sincerely hope you come out and enjoy the event! Following are photos some of the planes Jim will be bringing.
