Types of Outpatient Therapies

Speech Language Pathology / Speech Therapy (SLP)

SLPs help children feel more confident and discover how to communicate in a more functional way. Speech therapists also help children experiencing difficulties with social communication disorders, cognition, articulation disorders, stuttering disorders, and oral motor and feeding disorders.

Occupational Therapy (OT)

OT helps children gain independence by addressing underlying deficits. This may look like strengthening the development of fine motor skills, sensory motor skills, feeding skills, dressing skills, and visual motor skills. Addressing these skills helps them do everyday things like eating, putting on shoes and socks, focusing on learning, writing, and playing with toys or other kids.

Physical Therapy (PT)

PTs help kids improve their range of motion, strength, flexibility, and movement patterns. The goal is to help children move their bodies how and when they want to the best of their abilities. Pediatric PTs help make everyday activities easier for kids.

Applied Behavior Analysis Therapy (ABA)

ABA is a type of therapy that focuses on improving specific behaviors, such as social skills, reading, and academics, as well as, adaptive learning skills, hygiene, grooming, and domestic capabilities.

Feeding Therapy

Feeding therapy, in its simplest form, is when a trained occupational or speech therapist helps address any feeding difficulties or picky eaters expand and develop their skills. Dependent on your child's underlying issues, whether they be sensory, motor, or a combination of both, your therapist will devise a sensory motor approach for working on addressing the underlying barriers to your child's ability to eat an age-appropriate meal.
