Encourage your child to talk about how these special people help them whether they teach them, love them, encourage them, help them, or simply make them smile!

In support of the High Scope Curriculum, we are providing you with some skills to bring the High Scope curriculum home. The High Scope Curriculum's fundamental approach is an active learning model with five active ingredients: Materials, Manipulation, Choice, Child language & Thought, and adult scaffolding. Active learning is at the center of the High Scope Curriculum. It’s the foundation where young children gain knowledge through their natural play and interactions with the environment, events, and other people.

We have provided materials and encourage you to use any additional items you choose! The students can arrange the materials in any way they would like. Having a choice of materials allows the children to use their imaginations to show their own creativity. We encourage you to talk about the project and engage in a conversation that supports their understanding of creativity and creation.
