

#### Great Basin Transmission, LLC SWIP North Jerome County Special Use Permit Application

#### I. Executive Summary

Great Basin Transmission, LLC (GBT), is planning to construct the Southwest Intertie Project-North (SWIP North, or Project). SWIP North will be a 285-mile, 500-kilovolt (kV) electric transmission line, connecting the Midpoint Substation operated by Idaho Power Company (Idaho Power) and located in Jerome County (County), approximately seven miles south of Shoshone on U.S. 93, with the Robinson Summit Substation located near Ely, Nevada. GBT submits this application for a Special Use Permit (SUP) for those portions of the Project that cross private lands in the County and respectfully requests review and approval by the Planning & Zoning (P&Z) Commission in accordance with the Jerome County Zoning Ordinance (JCZO). GBT anticipates construction of SWIP North in Jerome County to commence within three years after final approval of this Application.

SWIP North is an inter-regional transmission project that will enable the bi-directional flow of energy for the purchase and sale of electricity among numerous resources and utilities across the West. The Project will enhance reliability for the regional electric grid, increase the supply of electricity into the Magic Valley, and improve resiliency for the electric grid in the event of western wildfires or extreme weather events.

SWIP North will enter the County from the south by crossing the Snake River, just south of Eden, and traversing northward approximately 24 miles to its terminus at the Midpoint Substation. The entirety of the Project that is located on private lands in the County will traverse lands zoned as "A-1 Agriculture" on the County's zoning map. GBT has acquired all necessary private land rights in the County.

As detailed in <u>Section IV</u>, the Project components to be constructed in the County will include tubular steel poles, using different configurations and aboveground utility lines. The Jerome County Zoning Ordinance (JCZO) requires a Special Use Permit for "Transmission Towers" located in A-1 zones (JCZO, Chapter 5, Chart 5-2). Other Project components, including "Above Ground Utility Lines," and other "Utility Building(s) & Structures, Communications (with direct physical connection)" are permitted uses in zone "A-1" and therefore do not require a Special Use Permit.

Idaho Power has entered into an agreement to participate in the Project. SWIP North will provide Idaho Power and other electric providers the ability to access abundant energy resources in the Desert Southwest, ensuring that Idaho consumers, including those within the Magic Valley, can benefit from the lowest-cost available energy, especially during winter months and emergencies like wildfires and extreme weather.

As detailed below, GBT is comprehensively addressing the Special Use Permit standards under the JCZO.

#### II. Background

The SWIP North Project represents the final phase of the larger Southwest Intertie Project (SWIP) (Figure 1), which is an approximately 516-mile transmission line extending from Clark County, Nevada, to Jerome County, Idaho. The SWIP project was originally permitted by Idaho Power in the early 1990s. In 2005, GBT acquired Idaho Power's rights to the entire SWIP. Since then, GBT has been advancing the project to completion.

In collaboration with NV Energy, GBT developed the southern portion of the SWIP, now known as the One Nevada Transmission Line (ON Line), from the Harry Allen Substation in Clark County, Nevada, to the Robinson Summit Substation in White Pine County, Nevada, which was completed in 2014. In 2020, the corridor was extended from the Harry Allen Substation to the Eldorado Substation via the DesertLink Transmission Line (DesertLink), providing Idaho with broader access to additional energy resources from the Desert Southwest.

SWIP North consists of the northern 285 miles of the SWIP. The northernmost portion of the Project will traverse Jerome County from Idaho Power's Midpoint Substation south to the Twin Falls County line at the Snake River, approximately 3.5 miles southwest of Eden. The Project will be located on both public and private lands.




Figure 2: U.S. Wholesale Electricity Prices in January 2024

Upon completion, SWIP North will allow utilities like Idaho Power and Rocky Mountain Power direct access to abundant energy resources in the Desert Southwest. Prices for these and other regional sources of electricity are at times more economical than those of existing resources, benefiting Idaho ratepayers. For example, during the cold snap in early 2024, Idaho utilities were forced to pay

as much as \$750 to \$1,000 per megawatt hour (MWh) in order to keep lights and heat running for Idaho businesses and residences. Had SWIP North been operating at that time, Idaho Power and other utilities could have imported surplus generation from the Desert Southwest at prices closer to \$100 per MWh (see Figure 2 for a snapshot example).

Adding north-south transmission capacity at Midpoint also enables the purchase and sale of surplus energy into and from the broader Mountain West and Pacific Northwest for Idaho consumers. Idaho utilities owning transmission rights into Midpoint will also benefit by selling excess transmission capacity to other regional utilities.

Idaho Power has entered into an agreement to participate in the Project, establishing commitments that enable Idaho Power to participate in SWIP North as a partial owner of the Project and that entitle Idaho Power to northbound transmission capacity rights on the line. Idaho Power has identified that SWIP North also offers other financial, risk, and reliability benefits such as: (1) grid reliability/resiliency, (2) economic efficiency, (3) improved resource reliability for existing Idaho Power resources, (4) support of contingency reserves, (5) the indefinite deferral of two planned transmission facilities, and (6) cost controls inherent with facility ownership. In March 2025, Idaho Power filed a request for approval to participate in SWIP North from the Idaho Public Utilities Commission, which approval is currently pending.

#### III. Project Route in Jerome County

SWIP North will cross over the Snake River into the County just south of Eden. From there, as shown in <u>Appendix A</u> and <u>Appendix B</u>, the route will traverse northward approximately 23.8 miles on private lands and federal lands, until it reaches its terminus at the Midpoint Substation. Midpoint Substation is operated by Idaho Power and is located approximately seven miles south of Shoshone on U.S. 93.

The SWIP North route was approved by the U.S. Bureau of Land Management (BLM) in 1994. The original route in Jerome County paralleled an existing Idaho Power transmission line, the Midpoint-to-Valmy line, which was built in 1981. Because of the co-location of these two projects,

the U.S. Congress designated the public lands containing these routes as an "Energy Right-Of-Way Corridor" under Section 368 of the Energy Policy Act of 2005 (Section 368 Corridor). As preferred locations for energy transport rights-of-way on BLM-managed public lands, "Section 368 Corridors are intended to facilitate long-distance movement of oil, gas or hydrogen via pipeline, and transmission and distribution of high-voltage electric power."<sup>2</sup>




Figure 3: SWIP North within the Section 368 Energy Corridor

In 2010, Congress re-routed the Project to reduce visual impacts and other impacts of the SWIP North line on the Minidoka National Historic Site (NHS). Now, a portion of the route near Hunt, Idaho, has been shifted a few miles to the west of the Midpoint-to-Valmy line. Nevertheless, the vast majority of the route in Jerome County continues to parallel the existing transmission line, as shown in Figure 3.




Figure 4: SWIP North route within Jerome County

Beginning at Midpoint Substation, the SWIP North route runs southeast in parallel with the existing Idaho Power line for approximately 10.6 miles, crossing public and private lands. The re-routed portion continues generally south for approximately 9.4 miles, before rejoining the existing Idaho Power transmission line for the remaining 3.8 miles to the Snake River. An overview map of the route in Jerome County is shown in Figure 4.

The breakdown of public lands from private lands for the 23.8 mile route in Jerome County is as follows:

<u>Public Lands</u>: Approximately 15.7 miles (66%) of the right-of-way traverses public lands managed by the BLM. The BLM lands are multiple use, used mainly for cattle operations and public recreational uses. An additional 0.06 miles consists of crossings of Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) highways.<sup>3</sup>

<u>Private Lands</u>: Approximately 8.05 miles (34%) of the route in Jerome County will be located on private lands. Of those private landowners, approximately 0.34 miles would be on Idaho Power-owned property for interconnection into Midpoint.

The remaining approximately 7.71 miles spans property owned by 11 private landowners. These private lands are used primarily for agriculture, such as crops and cattle farming. Of these, approximately 5.53 miles parallel an existing transmission line. The remaining 2.18 miles that deviate from the existing line are due to the 2010 Congressional re-route to minimize impacts to the Minidoka NHS. Of these 2.18 miles, approximately 1.26 miles (58%) are located within one-quarter mile of at least one existing transmission line.
