Enviro Waste Systems and our Members are dedicated to solving and being part of the solution to one of our biggest and least spoken about, social and environmental issues - this being the current dependency on land filling our waste. This outdated method causes many environmental issues including, for example, the production of Methane Gas from the decomposition of the waste.

When Methane Gas is released into the atmosphere it is 20 times more harmful than Co2 to the environment and traps 24 times more heat in our atmosphere than Co2, making it, in equivalent terms, as damaging to the environment as all of the worlds transportation utilities (Cars, Trucks, Ships, Planes, Trains etc.).

Simply by finding a better way to treat and utilise waste destined for landfill, we can improve the sustainability and future of our planet.

Energy Generation using fossil fuel does not only cause damage to our planet, but is also un-sustainable. It involves digging or drilling fossil fuels out of the ground, transporting them, then burning for the generation of Power and Heating or Cooling processes. Once is it used it does not regenerate, unlike waste to energy. Using fossil fuel, we pollute and harm the ecosystem and shorten the lifecycle of our planet.

Enviro Waste Systems intends to change this, by utilising our planets waste as a sustainable fuel. With the ongoing development of clean technologies for the treatment and recovery of energy, Enviro Waste Systems will provide the maximum amount of recovered energy while maintaining our mission:

"To Reduce, Reuse, Recycle and Recover materials wherever possible".



What we Do

Our Core Business is broken down into three main areas of focus These areas lend themselves to further diversification to tailor the right solution for either our client or our development partners.

- Public Private Infrastructure Developments

Enviro Waste Systems blends multiple technologies and systems together into a singular development which provides large scale public /private waste management, treatment and disposal infrastructure, combined with large scale sustainable energy generation systems. We provide Base Load Renewable and Sustainable Energy for dispatch into the national energy grid, at the same time reducing the Environmental, Social and Economic impacts to the community. With each 16-20 MWe development, we create on average 70-80 full time mixed skill jobs adding around 8 -10 million dollars into the local economy annually. We divert an average 150,000 – 200,000 tons of waste from landfill, which translates to the reduction of around 300,000 Tonnes of Co2E per year and we Generate on average 120,000 MWh of Renewable Base Load electricity, further reducing the demand on Fossil Fuels for Energy Generation.

- Developing Nations Energy & Waste Solutions

Enviro Waste Systems combines our proven technologies and services to the developing nations throughout the pacific region, providing alternative means for energy generation. We also incorporate waste management systems which are key to assisting the nations transition to a more environmentally sustainable future.

- Embedded Energy Generation & Distribution with Integrated Waste Management

Enviro Waste Systems have developed a small scale Energy Generation and Distribution system which is modular and can be coupled to match the client's own waste and energy needs.
