What We Require:

- A commitment of at least 2 hours per week or 10 hours per school semester. Students may only work a maximum of 4 hours per day when working special events.
- Dependability. Please be punctual for your scheduled shift and call the library at 606-287-8113 if you are unable to work. Teens that are absent and have not notified the library will be noted as "absent without notification" on the volunteer schedule. More than 2 "absent without notification" will result in losing eligibility to volunteer that semester.
- Eligibility and extra-curricular activities. Volunteers participating in extracurricular activities must work at minimum of 2 out of 4 scheduled Saturdays during a month to remain active on the Saturday shift. Shifts can be made up by working a different shift day or doubling a Saturday shift. Staff must be notified of these schedule changes.
- Dress code: the library follows the Public School dress code.
