Rev. Hymon first posed the 5 W's.

Who do we pray to?

What do we pray for?

When do we pray?

Where do we pray?

Why do we pray?

Rev. Hymon also used the **A.C.T.S.** Prayer Model to help us learn how to pray.

**A - Adoration** - Acknowledge the great things that God is doing.

**1 Chronicles 29:11** - "Thine, O Lord is the greatness, and the power, and the glory, and the victory, and the majesty: for all that is in the heaven and in the earth is thine; thine is the kingdom, O Lord, and thou art exalted as head above all."

**C** - **Confession** - When you confess, you repent.

**Proverbs 28:13** - Whoever conceals their sins does not prosper, but the one who confesses and renounces them finds mercy.

**T - Thanksgiving -** When we pray, we have to show God what he has done. We have to be thankful.

**Psalms 95:2-** Let us come before his presence with thanksgiving, And make a joyful noise unto him with psalms.

**S - Supplication - Present your request to God.** 

**Ephesians 6:18** Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;

We also learned that being disconnected from God, saying the same prayer, not believing in what we're praying for, distractions, and confusion are things that hurt our prayer life.

Each attendee was presented a prayer journal. Rev. Hymon also provided scriptures and attendees got to interact by finding that scripture in the Bible and telling who prayed and what happened. She concluded with review questions and prizes.

Deacon Jessie Craig let us know that there are different types of prayers (like the congregational prayer, offertory prayer, closing prayer, etc.) should be simple, direct, brief, and to the point. We must believe in what we are praying for and believe that when we ask, God will answer.

The adults enjoyed the workshop just as much as the youth. We want to thank Rev. Hymon, Deacon Jessie Craig, and all who attended.


