Every unit will be given a number to before the parade begins during line-up formation that should be displayed throughout the parade. Please arrive on time to line-up your unit(s) on the day of the parade:

- ENTRIES:** 1-60 ARE SCHEDULED TO LINE-UP FROM 6:30-7:00 A.M.  
61-120 ARE SCHEDULED TO LINE-UP FROM 7:00-7:30 A.M.  
121-180 END ARE SCHEDULED TO LINE-UP FROM 7:30-8:00 A.M.

**ONLY** those participants that have turned in participant release forms should be in your unit. It is the responsibility of the supervisor(s) for this unit to make copies and distribute this letter, together with the two parade maps, to all participants. **Participant drop-off is along Santa Ursula.**

**GENERAL ADMISSION BLEACHER TICKETS**

General admission bleachers will be located along Victoria St. between San Agustin and Convent and they will also be available in front of the LISD Civic Center's swimming pool. Tickets for general admission bleachers will only be available on-site the day of the parade.

**All units MUST check in at Lafayette & San Bernardo.**

**PARADE LINE-UP AREA**

Please see Parade Color Map for designated lineup area.

**DESIGNATED PICK-UP AREA** A well-lighted pick-up area for participants will be at St. Peter's Plaza.

**FLOAT ENTRIES DROPPING OFF** should stop at the intersection of Victoria St. and Davis St. to drop-off participants. Volunteers will be escorting children to St. Peter's plaza. Floats should then continue west on Victoria St.

**MARCHING UNITS DROPPING OFF** should stop at Victoria St. and Davis St. Volunteers will be escorting children to St. Peter's plaza.

**RIBBONS & TROPHIES**

All entries will receive a participant ribbon as they pass the Grand Stand located in front of the Laredo Civic Center. One 1<sup>st</sup> place trophy to be awarded per category. Winners will be announced in The Laredo Morning Times no later than March 3<sup>rd</sup>. Local prize-winning entries may pick-up their trophies at the WBCA office during the week of March 13<sup>th</sup>; out-of-town or international prize-winning entries will be contacted by telephone and or email to make arrangements for their trophy. Note: Parade Judge's decisions are final and all trophies must be picked up by March 31, 2018.

**BY ORDER OF THE FIRE MARSHAL**

**Each entry (float or non-float with a generator or electrical inverter) must pay an additional fee of \$20 for the City of Laredo Fire Dept. Permit for each parade and must carry an "All Purpose" 5-pound ABC Type Fire Extinguisher, inspected and tagged by a licensed fire extinguisher maintenance inspector.**
