

The following list is the required minimum inventory guide.

- ❖ All furnishings should be new, or in like-new condition. Upholstered furniture should be cleaned on a regular basis, lamp shades should be cleaned or replaced if necessary. Draperies and blinds should be in proper working condition and cleaned on a regular basis.
- ❖ Cablevision, local telephone service (if a landline is present), and high speed internet service (wireless preferred) are required in all residences. The guest will be responsible for any toll calls.
- ❖ Electricity, gas, propane, water, sewer, trash pick-up, condominium assessments, pest control (interior and exterior), all interior maintenance, repairs and replacements (including items like light bulbs), as well as working appliances, heating and cooling systems (including A/C filters), and other components of the residence.
- ❖ The residence must be professionally cleaned. Deep cleaning must be done at least once per year. Cabinets and drawers should have new shelf paper or lining from time to time, kitchen appliances should be clean, windows and patio doors should be washed, and tracks cleaned. Repainting should be done every few years.
- ❖ All personal belongings, photographs and prized possessions should be removed or stored in one owner's locked closet.
- ❖ We will personally inspect your residence prior to any seasonal guest's arrival and will arrange for necessary cleaning. First impressions are very important.

Screened porch / lanai / patio furniture

4 chairs

1 dining table

2 small tables

1-2 chaise lounges

Lighting, preferably a lamp if there is an outlet.

Unfinished patio floors should be tiled or carpeted.

Dining room furniture

1 dining room table

4 chairs (extra chairs if possible)

Living room furniture

There should be seating for at least five people in the living room and at least 2 reading lamps. Minimum sofa and loveseat preferred.

Bedroom furniture

The preference in the master bedroom is a king-size bed. The second choice is a queen-size bed, plus standard bedroom furniture.

The preference in a guestroom is twin beds.

Linens and bedspreads should be of good quality cheerful and light colors.

Reading lamps on nightstands and ample drawer space are very important.

One chair in each bedroom and a full-length mirror is appreciated.

Linens for bedrooms

2 sets of pillows and pillowcases

Mattress pad and pillow protectors (replaced yearly)

1 bedspread or comforter per bed

1 blanket per bed (extra blankets are recommended)

2 pillows per bed size - 1 pillow for each twin bed (should be unstained and in new condition)

Extra pillow cases

Note: If there is a sleeper sofa, extra pillows, sheets, pad and blankets are necessary.

Bathrooms

China soap-dishes, toothbrush holders and tumblers. (If not China, good quality material.)

Night lights

Wastebaskets

Bathroom cleaning supplies: soap, toilet tissue, robe hooks on doors, toilet bowl brush - "Use what you need but replace it for the next person."

6 matching sets per bathroom - bath, hand, wash cloths

4 beach towels - designate which towels you want taken to the pool or beach

Shower curtains with a shower curtain liner

Toilet seat covers are optional

2 scatter rugs (recommended to protect your flooring but are optional)
