
Metatarsalgia (MTPJ Synovitis) Pain in the ball of the foot

Metatarsalgia is a painful inflammation (synovitis) of the metatarsophalangeal joints (MTPJs, or ball of the foot). It is often described as a bruised feeling or a burning sensation. It is more common to occur in a foot with a dropped metatarsal arch, hammer toes, or with decreased cushioning in the ball of the foot. Callusing or corns of the skin under the MTPJs can occur. Symptons are worsened with prolonged activity on hard surfaces and with heeled shoes.



To treat this condition, the MTPJs need to be offloaded by a custom-made orthotic that has a metatarsal support to press on the metatarsal bone to take pressure away from the joint. Extra cushioning in the orthotic also helps to relieve pain in the ball of the foot.

Further treatment modalities include:

Orthotics Orthotic Adjustments Never going barefoot Orthopaedic footwear (Rocker Soled) Anti-Inflammatories (Oral and Topical) Injections: Steroid (Depo-Medrol, Kenalog, Decadron) Blood (PRP - Platelet Rich Plasma) Casting (Walking Boot) Other


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
