I'd like to email you two \$500 gift cards from two local restaurants, Just BE Kitchen and Etai's. Just want to confirm these will work for you! Thanks" . Wow what a gift he wants to support his favorite restaurant and give to help the community. So now we have a start but it still will not fill the 175-200 boxes of food that we are handing out. The day is busy a crew takes in food rescue sorts and refrigerates. It is now late and I sit down to prepare for bible study Luke 12: 22- 34

Do Not Worry

22 Then Jesus said to his disciples: "Therefore I tell you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat; or about your body, what you will wear. **23** For life is more than food, and the body more than clothes. **24** Consider the ravens: They do not sow or reap, they have no storeroom or barn; yet God feeds them. And how much more valuable you are than birds! **25** Who of you by worrying can add a single hour to your life^[a]? **26** Since you cannot do this very little thing, why do you worry about the rest?

27 "Consider how the wild flowers grow. They do not labor or spin. Yet I tell you, not even Solomon in all his splendor was dressed like one of these. **28** If that is how God clothes the grass of the field, which is here today, and tomorrow is thrown into the fire, how much more will he clothe you—you of little faith! **29** And do not set your heart on what you will eat or drink; do not worry about it. **30** For the pagan world runs after all such things, and your Father knows that you need them. **31** But seek his kingdom, and these things will be given to you as well.

32 "Do not be afraid, little flock, for your Father has been pleased to give you the kingdom. **33** Sell your possessions and give to the poor. Provide purses for yourselves that will not wear out, a treasure in heaven that will never fail, where no thief comes near

and no moth destroys. 34 For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

I stop and take a deep breath, If only I had this message this morning a constant reminder God cares for each of us and provides just what we need for the time.
