
EMPLOYEES MUST WEAR FACE COVERINGS

Employees must wear face coverings if the work entails close proximity to the public or co-workers. Civil or criminal penalty will not be imposed for failure to wear a face covering.



Face coverings are <u>not</u> a replacement for social distancing, frequent handwashing, and self-isolation when sick.

Infants and people with health conditions that may make breathing difficult should not wear masks, but should take precautions to socially distance from others.

Cloth face coverings should:

- Cover nose and mouth
- Fit snugly but comfortably against the side of the face
- Be secured with ties or ear loops
- Include multiple layers of fabric
- Allow for breathing without restriction
- Be able to be laundered and machine dried without damage or change to shape
