The Forest - by Annette Wynne

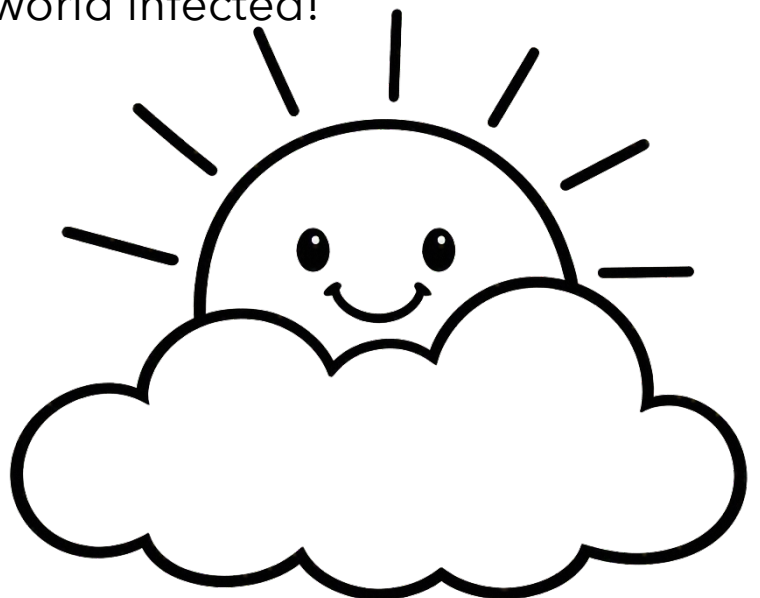
The forest is the town of trees
