Today the Jews of this seaside urban oasis live a few dollars away from covering their essential needs. Our fellow Yidden need our help for their basic health care, for a roof over their heads, and for their children.

Fortunately, one woman stands between the Jews of Bahia Blanca and abject poverty. Shlucha Sara Freedman brings our brethren fresh fruits and vegetables, money for essential medical treatments, and funds for rent relief, while at the same time caring for the spiritual needs of this struggling community.

With one US dollar equal to 374 Argentine pesos, your money will go far. Will you be the angel to fund food and doctor's bills for Cynthia, who works full time but cannot make ends meet since her non-Jewish husband left her and her three children?

Yaakov's dream is one we take for granted – to save his eyesight. Since the COVID crash, 65-year-old Yaakov lost his business and is working as a hospital administrator, but his \$800 per month is not enough for his medical treatment. Won't you be Yaakov's seeing eye sponsor?

Miriam is a single 30 year old art professor, and a regular helper and participant in Chabad events. Her family cannot support her financially while she recovers from the disease that has sapped her strength to the point that she cannot work. Can you give her the resources she needs to get back on her feet?

Funds are also needed for the Bais Chabad. Sara's husband, shliach Rabbi Moshe Freeman, passed away six years ago. A double lung transplant granted him eleven extra years, but he finally succumbed to complications. Sara selflessly conducts her mission of mercy in Bahia Blanca while raising the couple's three youngest children.
