He spoke about his struggles with fame and creativity in a way that was deeply moving. That interview stayed with me, especially when we lost him not long after."

She also recounts a hilarious and chaotic live interview with Mick Jagger. "It was my first time meeting someone of his rock-star caliber," Erica shares. "Mick was larger than life, effortlessly charming, and playful. He turned the tables and started asking me questions on air, which completely threw me off guard!
