The Long Road Home... I've come to realize in my latter years in life that all things have been purposed. Every event, good or bad, has brought me to this point. It has been a journey filled with experiences or what I have come to know as "choices". Each choice sets in motion a consequence. Many were not the right choice; however, even the bad choices ultimately took me closer to Home. Home meaning, Kingdom thinking. Being in Christ. Having a Christian belief in the return of Jesus Christ and the assurance that He is the present and future hope of believers. That He died on the cross for my sins and rose from the dead on the third day.

Our Blessed Hope, Jesus Christ allows us the free will to choose... to make a choice. His hand is in all of it. The greater the fall... the greater the lesson. If he couldn't go with me... I didn't go. Later I realized the separation from past friends and family. The disrupted holidays. The people I would avoid for him. I began to make new friends. People who shared my lifestyle. I was a dysfunctional, functioning alcoholic. Meaning that I could maintain parts of my life while other parts crumbled. It was a mask for the world. It was what I wanted everyone to see, not what was reality. Reality was that I was broken. I was broken emotionally, physically, and spiritually. Deep inside me I wanted change, but I had no idea on how to obtain it.

Many thought I was successful, as the world measures success, but I was unstable. Never dealing with the scars and trauma within me. I became hardened. Almost emotionless. I thought nothing could touch me. I thought I was invincible, but I was actually running away. Running away from the pain I could not face. Physical pain was easy compared to the emotional trauma within me. It was a pain I had no defense from and denied it all. Facing it scarred me more than anything. It was my Achilles heel. Something I feared I could not overcome or stand back up from. Even the thought of feelings scared me. Alcohol gave me the escape I sought.

I knew two emotions, anger and love; however my idea of love, at that time, was highly flawed. Love asks for nothing in return. Love expects nothing, but does everything for the sake of

another. Love has no promise or request behind it. To love for love's sake. Love does not have to be loved back. Christ is love and through Christ I can now love freely and continue to move forward in that understanding.

Knowing He loves me though I deserve nothing. Knowing He paid the price for my sins. How could I not be moved by that? He paid a price that I could not begin to pay back. No one else would stand in my place. No one, but He did. He washed me of my disgrace, my shame, my insecurities. Cleansed in the Blood of the Lamb. By His grace I am His. I owe Him everything. When I truly accepted Christ into my heart, my life did not immediately go from shame to glory, but there was a difference. A difference I could see and feel within me.
