He is the God Who restores... As I write this it is the five-month anniversary of my father's passing. Earlier this spring my dad got sick pretty suddenly and about six weeks later he left this earth and entered Eternity. Needless to say, it was a shock to our entire family... honestly, it still is. In the midst of it though, I got to know my Heavenly Father in a way I have never experienced. There were countless details that I know were orchestrated by the Lord, that allowed for myself and my dad's closest family to be with him in his final days and to all be at the hospital at the same time during his last breaths. There was a nurse on call the day of his passing that was the most amazing of all the staff he had during his time at the hospital. And hundreds more details that I could go on and on about. The most amazing moment though, was when we knew that it was nearing the end and there was nothing more to be done. We all came around my dad, bent over his hospital bed, as his heart rate slowly came down to zero. My arms were wrapped around him and I was singing quietly into his chest. There was such a strong sense that the Lord was there and was saying, "Your earthly daddy is leaving, but your Heavenly Daddy is right here." A moment of sorrow and a moment of peace all at the same time. In the days and weeks that followed, my Heavenly Father has been so close, so very close. I miss my dad so much, but I am so grateful that the Lord has shown me how near He really is, especially in our most trying times.

Perhaps you have/had a good relationship with your father. More than likely though, you had a poor, terrible or nonexistent relationship with your father. Even good relationships are not perfect and can leave some wounds. Poor to nonexistent relationships leave deeps wounds, pain and scars. Yet.... there is One who is a perfect Heavenly Daddy! As the Lord has been so much my Father these past months, He desires to be for you as well! He desires to come and heal the wounds in your heart! He desires to show you that you are loved! He desires to reveal His presence and peace to you in a way no one else can!
