

HATED WITHOUT A CAUSE

Something has most certainly shifted in the spirit realm, resulting in some of us walking around with targets on our backs to a heightened level by those who deem us their enemy, when we do not consider them ours. If you have a tender heart and are sensitive, you might be feeling a little perplexed, unsettled, upset and grieving due to random people, even loved ones, all of a sudden finding themselves with hardened hearts towards you... in which they start to perceive you as their foe, instead of friend suddenly out of nowhere.

This may happen to those you have laid your life down and loved unconditionally or even a stranger may look at you threatening without any provoking on your part. After the initial shock of it all, sadness can set in, so we need to look unto Jesus and His Word for explanation and encouragement. By now you are already on one side of the coin or the other... Some may think, who cares? While many of you may be thinking... this is me and you are grieved.

Thankfully, the Lord made each of us different and yet all precious in His sight... so in this case, there isn't a wrong stance to take, just a different one, depending on how sensitive you are in the heart and how the Lord has led you to love others and lay your life down. I would be disingenuous if I told you I do not care when this happens to me. As a matter of fact, I do care, probably a bit too much. But, I am comfortable enough in how the Lord has designed me to understand, my heart is just a little more tender to pain than most, as is many of yours. And that's okay... We love greatly in this way, because He has loved us greatly the same way. We may get wounded, yet Jesus binds up those wounds and heals our broken hearts, like only He can.

But back to the point of this message... Jesus too, was "Hated without cause..." But before we go there today – let's not assume automatically there is no cause... Those with tender hearts like this, have a tendency to always think they've done something to cause the retaliation from a loved one – which isn't necessarily a bad thing – it is always, always good to reflect first, to truthfully look into our own hearts and actions to honestly know if we've provoked someone in anyway, big or small. Jesus tells us, "As much as it depends on us, to be at peace with all..." Being of a contrite heart, we admit there are times the fault falls on us. We are human, we react sometimes in ways that are not always pleasing... its life, its human nature. For the spiritually mature, we reflect first before we look elsewhere when strife enters into a relationship. Once we pass that test, we may move on to deeper spiritual understanding of the conflict and IF the Lord wants us to do anything or just remain silently in prayer for His divine intervention. Most often, we do nothing but pray and seek Him to give us, love, healing and peace. Weird thing I've noticed, when we do not intervene and have patience to wait – the storm passes and the person can see again that you are a friend and not a foe. Not always, but often this happens over time unless the person chooses to continue to oppose themselves unwilling to be a peacemaker instead of a strife causer. Our issue is, due to lack of patience and trust in the Lord to handle it, we take matters into our own hands, making it worse. I've done both... but am learning to just let go and let God, I hope you are too.

I just went through this... probably one of the most painful, but I must say it lasted a much shorter time because I didn't do anything but pray and wait and I talked only to the Lord about the pain it was causing in my heart – this is a new leaf moment for me I must admit. I usually will seek out the counsel of those close to me in times like this in addition to the Lord. This went on for days and I kept calling out to Him, then one day when I was making my bed, the Lord said to me in my heart... "Why do you think that what happened to Me won't happen to you? They hated Me without CAUSE too." Those words of His in that moment, healed and comforted me instantly. I get it now... If the mobs conjured in their heads Jesus was like the devil, when in all actuality He was the purest form of love that ever stood before them and they perceived Him as doing evil towards them and not good, then of course, I too with all my frailties and shortcomings would easily

suffer the similar type treatment from those who gravitate towards the whispers the enemy places in their minds. And there's so much more to this, but you know what I am saying.

Here's a made up saying, people often repeat as if it originates in the Word... "People are against me for my faith..." That isn't true, what will get us at odds with others quickly is when we carry the attributes of Jesus inside us. The children of the night despise those who walk in the light – so its all spiritual, darkness has no place with light, so are the dark ones reject the light, you are the fallout of something spiritually manifesting in the natural. Assuming someone doesn't like you for your faith is prideful. It lifts us up instead of Jesus, like we have the edge on walking with Jesus. Every single time we find ourselves in this conflicting situation the very first thing a child of God does is look inwardly to insure they have not drifted, instead of pointing fingers at the other person. In honesty, we must ask ourselves... Have I been kind? Have I shown unconditional love in place of haughtiness and judgment? Is there anything unclean on my hands or lips towards this other person that provoked them? Has my interaction with them come from a place of humbleness? And if not, the Lord will often utilize what is in them, to humble us in order we do not wear our own faith like a badge, proudly as if we are a cut above the fray of many. If we are going to boast on anything whatsoever, it should be on the Lord. Outside of Him, all of humanity is on equal ground, including us. So just a reminder, when conflict arises, look inward and ask yourself... What part in this did I play? Own it, confess it and then Jesus can move quickly for peaceful resolution. Keep in mind, our Lord is continually softening and hardening hearts... He is fully able to soften the other person's heart towards you or even harden it for His perfect will to be done in us. We cannot just pray the Father's will to be done, we must long for it, believe in it and trust it.

I do not apologize or feel bad anymore for crying to my Father in Heaven. This is something I have had to sort out and learn as I go since I never had a consistent father on Earth. I am not talking about crying and complaining, which is not at all what gets our Father in Heaven's attention. He turns a deaf ear to our murmuring. I think of it more like a newborn infant that's suffering discomfort crying and waiting and hoping their caregiver do for them what they cannot do for themselves. That's how I see us in our pain crying out for our Father and that is just the cry He attends to immediately. That cry does not accuse the one who harmed them or blame the Father for condition but for those who sincerely seek His comfort above a solution, knowing the resolve shall come eventually, but sometimes all we really need is His comfort.

As far as what I was going through... all glory to the Lord it is resolved now, for the time being anyway. Thank You Lord. He teaches us to much in these times, using examples of how He desires we behave and respond as His child, outcasts from the World, representing Him to the best of our abilities. I don't know about you... but I despise my ego, how I look to self instead of others during conflict as if I have clean hands and a clean heart in both intentions and actions. Ego totally stresses me out, especially my own... Ego wants to cry out as a victim all the time, ugh... When in truth our ego must die daily or we will not be counted among the sheep with a Shepherd, instead we are Shepherding ourselves. I do not like the "poor me" that rises up in myself or others... it's a constant slaying we must do when it does.

So full circle... Of course they hated Jesus without cause and like He said because of Him they will hate us too at times or all the time. But so what? Aren't we already supposed to be dead to self? And if we were... it wouldn't matter then would it? What did Jesus do in those moments? He sure didn't play the victim, but loved them anyway because He knew, they knew not what they were doing. So the next time you are faced with this sort of hatred... don't think its because you are great, but rather imitate Jesus in humility and love, praying He not hold against them anything they've said or done or even perceive against you. Have patience and wait for Him to intervene and offer forgiveness knowing that we too quite often need that same

forgiveness for things we do unknowingly to others and against our Lord Jesus. Mercy given to others is mercy we in turn receive from the Lord and we all need piles of it daily sometimes.

Next... You all know quite often Michael and I will have these incredible conversations on the phone centered on Jesus and the revelation and pearls the Lord blesses us with is so uplifting and encouraging. Well, this happened a couple nights ago so I started taking notes – keep in mind it was totally unplanned. So I thought I would share some of our pearls with you all today, in hopes it blesses you too! We often say, we wish you all could hear us talking sometimes... and since that isn't possible, I wrote many things down, which are just a culmination of what we shared back and forth.

- We first started talking about “soothsaying...” mentioned in Micah 4. Which means to be a forecaster, psychic, gut feeling, witchcraft, our version of truth, vain imaginations – **ALL RELATING TO RELIGION, THE BIBLE, SPIRITUAL THINGS, ETC...** A soothsayer in this context is within the church, speaking in references pertinent to the church of God. And I believe Michael said it best, so I wrote it down... **THOSE WHO SPEAK FOR GOD WITHOUT HIS LEADING THEM TO DO SO.** In other words, they say “thus says the Lord, but He actually said nothing or did not provoke them to speak.”
- Next we started talking about the Children of the day [who are truly saved, not just assuming they are] and Children of the night [who still excuse and keep sinful ways unwilling to repent] Right now both are growing up together, but the defining line between the two is gradually being seen as the Lord is revealing the true intentions of all our hearts. It is getting harder and harder for people to hide under the guise of Christianity because His light is revealing our inner truth. Michael said this will continue to increase until all that is hidden within humanity is revealed before all men by the light. Hypocrisy seems to be at an all time high, because the Lord is exposing it, not because it has increased.
- Anything that can control us is a sin. A partner, a habit, thoughts, desires, whatever the case may be is only a sin if it can control us more than the Lord does. So in essence... something may not be a sin for you because it cannot control you – could be a drastic sin for me and vice versa. Which is why we should not be concerned about the specks in others eyes – but the plank in ours. Which is ego by the way, another reason I cannot stand ego... I am trying to think of something as an example... Okay, lets say you are tempted to drunkenness so you start declaring condemnation over every one who drinks alcohol... But I do not have that sin/control in my life... The Word says – do not drink to the point of drunkenness, it does not say do not drink alcohol. Alcohol is not a sin for me, it is for you because it can control you, but not me. Oh I have another one, a good one... Youtube, Youtube might be sinful for many if you permit it to control you or feed you that which is unholy... Ego may even brag you do not watch tv and yet you are feasting on Youtube day and night. For me personally, Youtube could become much more sinful quickly due to the fact I like to watch true crime stories – if I do not purposely keep it in it's proper placement in my life. But for you, that is likely not an issue whatsoever, it's just my issue. And even if I am praying for justice and salvation for the one accused and lifting up the loved ones and such... it can quickly overtake me if I am not careful. So for me, Youtube could become very sinful in this way – which probably sounds silly, but I am truly being honest. I am not tempted by alcohol at all, but can get drunk on true crime court proceedings quickly... So lets always be mindful of what is trying to set up control over us, in order we may be fully set free from all that which besets us as sin and overrides our desire to imitate Jesus.
- Next we talked about how tares carry the spirit within of the fallen, which are simply demons by the way. In order to fall away... even the great one upcoming, a person **MUST** agree with the beast. And I loved this one thing Michael said so much I made him say it twice... **THE FLESH CANNOT SIN BY ITSELF, WE MUST AGREE WITH IT.** Don't you just love that? We do not **HAVE** to sin, we

just believe the lie we must do so... This is after we become a new creature in Christ, of course. Before then, we all sinned and fell short of the Lord – but after saved, we will only sin if we agree to do so. We agree to the lusts of the flesh or we reject them and whatever we choose, we will become and walk out... Basically, we must surrender to the Lord fully to be purified from all of that which taints us and opposes God's perfect will for us as His child. We choose whether to be His or not, no one to blame for disobedience by ourselves. The devil didn't make us do anything, we just choose to do that which he presented before us. If someone chooses to continue to lie to themselves, they will eventually become one with that lie – drug, alcohol and sex addicts do this all the time, sadly and without the Lord's divine, sometimes harsh intervention they will eventually be given over to that lie/a reprobate mind without possibility of returning to a sober minded state where they can actually hear the still small voice of the Lord.

- You conscience is not seared if you are in truth a child of the day, because you now feel the weight of sin and death and therefore with the Lord's power within are more easily able to reject it's influential grip upon you. We all know what happens to those with a seared conscience, they are eternally lost... it is a great gift to keep a soft heart and conscience for the Lord, able to feel the weight of it when we sin against Him so that the enemy has no grip or placement in our lives any longer.

Finally, we talked about this epiphany I had the day before I wanted Michael to weigh in on... I hope this won't sound like a ramble because its only in parts that the Lord gave me and I took notes on what Michael shared too. Maybe something good can come out of the court trials I often listen to... because this is how all this started in the first place. Part of serving in our Prison Ministry is linked to the trials, but that is a long story...involving constant prayer.

Last week while working I was listening to the trial of that poor little Athena who was stolen out of her yard at nine by a devil in a Fed Ex delivery truck, raped, tortured for an hour and killed, then he threw her precious little body into a river. If led, please pray for her family, who is shattered, hopeless and brokenhearted and for him, this monster to be saved from eternal damnation for what he did, his name is Tanner, he definitely a brute beast destined for a horrific future should he not call upon the Name of the Lord Jesus.

Anyway... as this forensic psychologist was speaking something earth shattering came out of his mouth that was really eye opening to me regarding two things: 1 – the Beast 2 – those who have a desire to KNOW the deep secrets of satan to their own demise. So that's the gest of it all on how I got here, so now I can share what Michael and I talked about...

Are you all familiar with the DSM? During my whole career up until the ministry work, I relied a great deal on the DSM for my clients, as do many in the mental health field. Here is what the DSM does in a nutshell:

The Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders (DSM) is the definitive, authoritative guide published by the American Psychiatric Association (APA) to diagnose and classify mental health disorders. Used by clinicians and researchers, the current DSM-5-TR (Text Revision) provides standardized criteria for diagnosing psychiatric conditions

It is like a CT scan for emotions, behaviors, thoughts as tool that labels people for the approach of diagnosing to treat them accordingly.

What I learned, that I was not aware of from prior experience is this... Under the DSM testing there is a new category under scoring called: Morbid Curiosity... WOW... This parallels to those who have a "desire to know the deep secrets of satan..." To many of us murder has never, nor would even enter into our minds

because it is not found within the heart. Same is true regarding death/morbid/evil curiosity which is all encompassed within the “beast...” the flesh mind... evil and not good, darkness and not light.

This morbid curiosity... is a real thing, as we know and have learned in our studies about the Church of Thyatira – that has growing works for the Lord and they gravitate to false prophets with the influences of Jezebel and control, they seduce, commit fornication like it is okay and many idols they do worship and because even though they were given time to repent by the Lord removing Himself from their presence – they refused to repent. Refusal to repent will cause any of us to be cast into that very thing we’ve imagined and desired but the Word specifically documents those who... **DESIRE TO KNOW THE DEEP SECRETS OF SATAN...** or rather have a “Morbid Curiosity...” But those who overcome, do so first by repenting and second resisting the desire of the flesh to know deep secrets about evil and such.

Alright, next thing... Each human is born with a Godly fear within us to both detect and avoid a predator... And what is a predator in the Bible? A **BEAST**, even a brute beast on some occasions. Within us we already have a warning system – unless we become **LIKE THE BEAST**, having a desire to know such deep things of evil so much we can no longer hear the voice of goodness from the Lord. His voice is still, small, quiet... Beasts are loud, aggressive and block out to override all that which is good. But here is how evil is prevailing, overtaking and overcoming many saints... first the desire comes to know, then you hear, then you follow and then you become... like a beast. You see until most recently beasts, predators used to be primarily animals, not humanity so much or at least it wasn’t prevalent like it is today. Because of what the Lord placed within humans, humans all these generations would come up against an animal (beast of the Earth) and be able to discern is this a predator or friendly? For example... a crocodile or a bunny rabbit – without even being told a human can discern whether or not, even as a child... they are facing a beast of the field. So what was animals we needed to discern has now turned into people – those who are behaving like a beast.

Just like in the Days of Noah... where it says in the Word is indicative of one major evidence... **VIOLENCE INCREASED UPON THE EARTH...** or also that horse that is riding to **TAKE PEACE** from the Earth. Which is why God’s children are to hold their peace...and not let it go, leading to violent tendencies.

Anyway, I hope this is making a little sense, sorry to be all over the place... but even know those who are in the world are aligning with the Word of God’s prophecies and many do not even know it... Amazing how our Father has His oversight into everything...

To sum all this up I am going to share what Michael said about all this the Lord gave me... He said the flesh without the Holy Spirit is a beast and the beast shall – gather all his own to himself, they will be beastly because they know him intimately and will imitate him. The beast shall rule over his kingdom followers, just as Jesus does with His. These tares, evil seeds in flesh bodies are spirits of old, indwelling the new bodies of humanity who walk the Earth today. Each person born has – either a bloodline of God being his child or of the beast/satan carrying his line forward.

Okay here is the scariest and sobering part... A beast or tare doesn’t know they are who they truly are of the heart. They do not know Jesus will say **I NEVER KNEW** you... they have completely rejected the ways of Jesus even if they are convinced they are doing all things right, they are right only in their own eyes, leading themselves, refusing to repent and be saved for real. They are drawn away by curiosity and by killing with the sword of which they will die by. So here’s the litmus test, in case you are wondering... and sadly I see this every single day in chat... What topics perk your ears up? Is it God’s Word or knowing secrets of evil? What you desire reveals your true nature. I see people be bored and about asleep when Michael is teaching from the Word of God, silent in chat and then he switches to topics enhancing secrets of satan, ufo’s, ghosts, aliens, evil spirits and such and all of sudden a flood of posts with **QUESTIONS** flood into chat... Do you all

not know that questions are just that? A desire to get answers about the deep secrets of satan? Questions are birthed out of curiosity... For many, we do not have such questions within us, nor do we can or attune our ears to the answers because that desire to know is not hidden within us. We have a desire for the sincere milk of the Word and meat that can only be given as manna from the Word of the Lord.

Alright, I did what you asked of me Lord, I shared what was given... and pray every one who heard this message today, please seek the Lord for further guidance. I have done my part, the rest is between you and Him and I am confident only with those who have ears to hear shall hear what the spirit is saying to the churches. And just as the serpent was already in the garden when Adam and Eve showed up, so is the beast already among us, lying in wait for his next person to draw into his snare through curiosity. The Lord is purging from within us all tendencies of darkness in that when darkness shows up our light casts it away, so it has positively nothing within us to cling to. We surrender to Jesus, resist the enemy and he flees away from us.

Ugh... enough dirty talk... And I don't want to end the broadcast on such a dark note. Let's wash off the residue of all that with some words of truth to uplift us found in God's Word.

Hebrews 4:12 tells us...

The Word of God is living, active, and sharper than any double-edged sword, penetrating deeply to divide soul and spirit, joints and marrow.

When we read and apply God's Word... it most certainly affects our flesh, in a good way, dividing that which is good and removing that which is not good for us, as dynamic force that judges the heart's thoughts and intentions, transforming believers and acting as an instrument of divine scrutiny in a very good way.

Key Aspects of the Word Being "Alive and Active":

- **Dynamic and Powerful:** The word is continually at work in the lives of believers
- **Piercing and Discerning:** It functions like a surgical instrument, exposing inner motivations, desires, and thoughts and skillfully removing all that contaminates our souls
- **Transformative:** It is "God-breathed" (2 Timothy 3:16) and effective for teaching, rebuking, correcting, and training.
- **Imperishable Seed:** It acts as a spiritual seed, capable of reproducing spiritual life (1 Peter 1:23 – and once watered... the Father shall give great increase in our lives what was sown by His Word
- **When reading and applying His Word** – We grow into spiritual maturity, as a perfect fruit, ready for harvesting
- **The Lord uses us to carry and share His Word with others too, we plant, we water** – only He gives the increase of Himself in other's lives and ours too
- **In order to grow, we must read and apply what is written** – both are required for the Lord to do a quick work within us, otherwise we could end up only full of knowledge, but not alive – spiritually dead

Just in case you are not in the habit of reading the Word on a consistent basis, there's no time like today to start! Quite often people will tell me God doesn't talk to them... I always ask them if they are reading their Bibles? Because it is in His Word, we know without question it is Him speaking and not something else.

Every once in awhile, I will go back and just read all the words in red in the NT, which are Jesus's words. You can also read one chapter in Proverbs a day for a month, since there are 31 chapters. Or pray first and just randomly open your Bible to any place in your Bible – read it and expect the Lord to speak to you with a personal message from Him.

Just like plants needs water to grow... Our souls need the Word of God as water to grow.
