A Message from a Friend ~

I just wanted to share with you all my experience as one who is a Pen Pal to a couple inmates. I just recently had gotten a new inmate and the Lord placed within my heart to go a little deeper with him about myself. My first Pen Pal has been great and we made friends quickly. This time I wanted to get to know them deeper, so I could be a better encouragement, based on their fears and doubts while walking with Jesus. I prayed, asking God to use me for His good purpose, so my first letter to him included my own personal testimony, which ended up being close to 20 pages. I told him about myself, leaving off the part where I was currently at... In "The Valley," which can sometimes be such a dark place you feel as if you will never get out of it; you often cannot see as you simply hold your hands up and pray the Lord will reach down and grab your hand. Eventually, when the light comes and you see the Lord was walking with you, guiding you through the dark the whole time. In these valley moments we change and grow and become more like our Lord Jesus. I do not know about you, but I've sat down, cried and rolled in the dirt many times in these moments. I finally learned to just keep moving and looking unto the Lord because it is in those times we actually, "Get over ourselves" so that Jesus can use us to serve others. I then began looking for someone to help everywhere I went, starting small I helped with bags at the store, doctor's offices, etc... And miraculously, as soon as I started to serve others, my dark valley got much brighter. As an extra bonus, I found these people I helped often turned around and ended up helping me. Back to the Prison Ministry... When I decided to become an inmate's Pen Pal, I simply thought this was just another way I could assist someone, but in a different way. Never in a million years did I imagine the plan the Lord had set in place as a blessing for me. I received my first letter and as I read the words my heart got hot and tears ran down my face to the point I ended up sobbing uncontrollably. My inmate began by sharing Judges 6:12, which talks about Gideon being a man of valor and how God was with him. Words cannot describe how blessed I was by my new inmate; this man who is placed in the worst of conditions took time to encourage me, telling me the Lord is with me. This inmate, a purposed brother was reaching out to serve someone else, ME and to show me the hand of the Lord is around me. I am still touched by his lovingkindness towards me and look forward to what else the Lord has in store for us on our spiritual journey together with Him.

I am writing to encourage you all to do the same... Look hard for opportunities to serve others whenever you can, in that your joy be made full too! Jesus is coming soon in the clouds, but He tells us to keep working for Him because the harvest is plentiful and the workers are few. Be real, God made you perfectly and He made you exactly what someone else needs for hope and encouragement. You just never know how you will touch another in their time of need, in which you end up being the one blessed, like I was. If God can use me, He can use anybody, including you!
