We make our products available digitally because our customers find this method to be the best and quickest way to receive our products. To continue to make the quality products you know and love from Illustrated Ministry, we ask that you are careful about how you share your digital file purchases.

As you use these worship resources, there may be times that you want to share files with teachers, volunteers, and families. We've found that there are three good ways to share our files with your community.

Email: Depending on the size of your congregation, you could email files to people who are interested in them. Another option is to put an announcement in your bulletin, asking those interested in receiving the files to email the person with access to the resource.

Note: Do not include links to download or attachments of our files in any emails/newsletters that are posted publicly online with services like Mailchimp, Constant Contact, because those become searchable by Google and the files become accessible to the general public.

Posting Online: We generally discourage posting our files online because many times, they quickly become accessible through Google Searches. Obviously, we don't want the general public to have access to our products. However, if your church has an easy way to put a password on a specific page on your website, you could place the files behind a password-protected page. Please remember to take the files down after you are no longer using them.

Note: Do not post the password in your bulletin or newsletter that gets posted publicly online.

Print: Most congregations who purchase our digital files choose to print out the materials for their community. Printing out the materials is probably the easiest way to share the Illustrated Children's Moment Leader Guides with whoever is going to use them. We also encourage printing out the color illustrations to share with children during worship.


FINISH THE DRAWING
