

**District One Meeting
July 18, 2023**

Debbie called the meeting to order, Jack was excused.

Roll Call: 7-11 (2); Riverton (2); Copper Ridge (2); Tooele (2); Stansbury (2); Rowdy Riders (2)

Financial Report: \$8,564.15

Minutes--Courtney motioned to accept the minutes, Jill seconded the motion, All For

Youth Show Rule Change Proposals

Age change from 6-8 to 8 and under

This rule change was discussed very thoroughly. After this discussion, Kim Payne made a motion to keep the age group as 6-8 with board approval for youth under 6 based on safety. Glendy seconded the motion. All For

Limit teams to 3 (A, B & C) per age group or keep unlimited teams

This rule change was discussed very thoroughly. After this discussion, John made a motion to add the rule that there is a limit of 3 teams (A, B & C) per age group, per club. Jamie seconded the motion. 6 For, 4 Against, 2 abstained, Motion passed.

Angie W. mentioned for clubs to be able to move a team up to a different age group to fill teams in that age group. For example--if there are 4 teams in the 6-8 age group and 2 in the 9-12 age group, allow 1 of the 6-8 age group teams to move up to the 9-12 age group. Teams could not move down an age group. This would allow a club to still have the same number of youth participating. It was decided that this needs to be taken back to the clubs and brought back to the September meeting for a vote.

John mentioned changing the rule in the flag race to take out the part of the rule stating it is a penalty if the flag is touching the side of the bucket. After some discussion, he decided to withdraw the suggested change.

Assignments for timers, stewards and setting up events are going to reviewed and adjusted. These assignments will be sent out after updated.

We have ribbon for ribbon pull and ribbon tying. We have string for break-away roping. We have food coloring for water race. Debbie has reorganized the district box and made a list of all items in the box. Please put equipment back in proper containers after use. There are 2 rubber batons and 2 wooden batons.

Kim P. asked what type of team penning #'s we wanted, the team penning #'s that of placed on the neck or the body. After a discussion, it was decided to use the #'s that are placed on the body.

Angie W. suggested that beginning next year, we may set up a document that allows clubs to enter their own teams for the shows, instead of turning them into the secretary. There would still be a deadline for entries. Only 1 person per club would have access to this document. This was tabled for now.

Region--

Any changes to the district show results that need to be made, need to be made ASAP. Region entries need to be submitted on Sunday Aug 13.

Stall reservations need to be submitted to Dave Peay (801-921-9852) on Sunday, Aug 13th. He will not take any reservations until then.

State--

Stewards need to be in sestern attire, shirts done up and tucked in. Timers do not need to be in western attire.

State reservations for stalls, RV parking etc. may not be made until Sunday, September 3

DISTRICT ONE IS IN CHARGE OF BREAK AWAY AND POTATO--ALL EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES (BARRIER, POTATOES, SMALL BARRELS, ETC.)

Misc--

Everyone needs to go over the rule book and know the rules.

Each club and members are responsible to qualify by riding in the parade or grand entry.

Need to make sure that the stop watches are working correctly. CELL PHONES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO BE USED TO TIME.

Broken pattern will be a DQ.

No hats are to be picked up until the entire team has completed the run. Only one member of the team is to pick up all hats.

STEWARDS ARE NOT TO PICK UP HATS DURING THE EVENT!!!

NO inhumane treatment will be tolerated

Protests need to be submitted in written form and with fee prior to the next event.

If a team feels like they were interfered with for any reason, they need to stop the event and call foul. If they continue with the event, their call of interference will not be allowed.

Only 50% of the team can be change--not horse can change in a single event

In single events, the gate will be open to start, but will be closed after entry. No one will be allowed to run out the gate.

Hide Race--If the hide rider misses the hide or if the horse rider drops the rope, the team is DQ.

There is only one attempt at the event. The horse rider may not go around the barrel a second time.

Aug District meeting (Not show meeting) was discussed whether to have an in person meeting or a video meeting. John made a motion to have a "Teams Video Meeting", Angie W. seconded the motion. All For
