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

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**5) Brush Clearance:** Clearly way too much time on my hands but I was thinking.... We have all seen these visiting idiots running across PCH between Dizz's and Solana. Scares the hell out of me and like many other things, there is not going to be one grand solution but... I have seen remarkable amounts of progress made by solving small parts of bigger problems that ultimately add up to big solutions.

One thing that can be done is to clear the brush from the temporary sidewalk between Dizz's and PCH. This is a narrow strip of asphalt that was snuck in by the city quite a while ago to improve the safety of using that strip for neighborhood parking. This was done so people were not forced to walk out on PCH.

The area is controlled by CalTrans but they have nothing official there so no maintenance. The city really had no right to put the asphalt in so they also don't have any real ability or budget to maintain it.

Erick Kirkland and I cleared an initial stretch of this last spring and what I am wondering is if there are a few more people that might consider some occasional short term efforts at clearing the sidewalk? The city did donate a bunch of cleanup bags and will pickup anything we can bag up. Eric and I have a bunch of tools. You would need some gloves.

The city is looking into creating one of the built over trashcan sites so it is not an eyesore. Very preliminary, something that needs to be run by the people that live around that corner, etc. but if an acceptable place and look can be accomplished, it would be a big help.
