Academic Regalia & Honours

The academic regalia worn by university graduates today trace their origins back to universities of the Middle Ages. During the eleventh and twelfth centuries heavy clothing composing of gowns and hoods were necessary to protect students and monks from the cold and dampness of medieval monasteries and castles, which housed many of the first universities. Over time modern academic regalia have been standardized around the length and shape of sleeves to the colour of ones hood.

The gown's sleeve indicates the level of degree earned. The Bachelor's gown has long pointed sleeves and is worn closed. The Master's gown has oblong sleeves, which are open at the wrist or upper arm, with the base hanging down. The Doctor's gown is indicated by bell-shaped sleeves with three bars or velvet chevrons. The Presidential gown has four bars or velvet chevrons in honour of the high office held.

The most prominent of all symbols is the academic hood. The hood reflects the level of degree attained along with the area of discipline and the institution from which the degree was earned. The hood varies in length based on the level of degree earned. Students earning the associate degree are honoured with a cowl made entirely of velvet with three coloured stripes indicating the institution from which the degree was earned.

Students who have excelled in their studies are recognized by way of Academic Honours. Southern College is pleased to recognized our students of academic excellence in the following categories:

Honours | Minimum Cumulative GPA: 3.00

Cum Laude | Minimum Cumulative GPA: 3.55

Magna Cum Laude | Minimum Cumulative GPA: 3.75

Summa Cum Laude | Minimum Cumulative GPA: 3.90


