Pat Binger passed from her earthly presence on February 27 from pancreatic cancer. Pat and Mac Binger supported the creation of Cheerful Heart back in 2003 as financial supporters and volunteered driving patients and serving soup at the Oncology Clinic. Pat served soup until she was diagnosed with cancer, about four months ago.

Pat's character is exemplified in her obituary... She was an active member and president of Western Montana Cattlewomen, supportive of her church circle, a Campfire and 4-H leader, active in Bible studies, co-author of a Chronological Biblical Character study, a member of P.E.O. and a director of the McKnight Foundation.

Pat was always present at her children's activities and especially proud of their lives... After her children left home, as an empty nester she had time to implement more of her ideas. Among her favorites was All In Stitches—More than A Quilt Shop, which she purchased because she "didn't want to see another business in town close"....

Pat provided her beloved community a lasting gift, Petra – a bronze sculpture of the Flathead Lake Monster at Sacajawea Park.



Lake City Bakery & Eatery has supplied bakery items for the Polson Oncology Clinic since Cheerful

Heart began. In the past couple of years the bakery either donates, or charges very little, for their baked goods.

Each Tuesday morning a Cheerful Heart volunteer picks up bakery items from Lake City Bakery and delivers them to the Oncology Clinic where cancer patients and families enjoy a sweet.

The business, owned by Mike and Deneya Humphrey, has been open for 55 years and lead baker Mike has worked there since he was 10 years old, when his parents operated the business.

Mike, whose grandfathers both were bakers, proudly describes himself as a "third-generation scratch baker." He and Deneya purchased the business from his mother, Marilyn Humphrey, in 2016. His workday, five days a week, begins at 3 a.m., when he begins preparing doughnuts in the kitchen downstairs.
