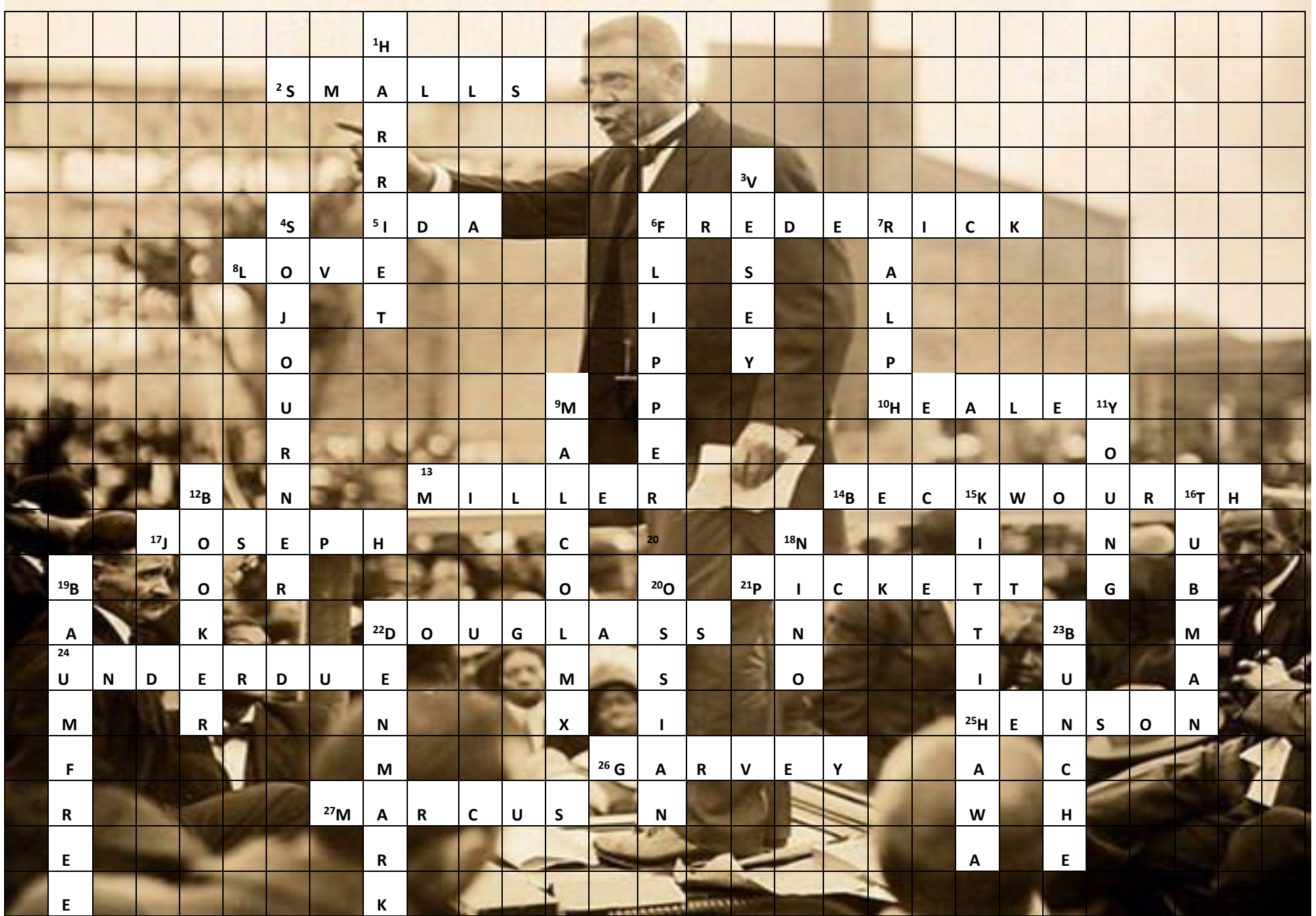


Black CouTours' Adventurers and Civil Rights Puzzle (#3)

5. Female activist who gained an audience with President William McKinley to advocate for reforms against lynching and discrimination, first name (**Ida B. Wells**)
6. Former slave who consulted with President Lincoln during the Civil War, first name (**Frederick Douglass**)
8. Black Cowboy who earned the title of Deadwood Dick when he entered a cowboy contest in Deadwood, SD and won. Considered the greatest black cowboy of the old west, last name (**Nat Love**)
- 10 First American Black to be ordained a priest, last name (**James Augustine Healey**)
- 13 Shot down four Japanese bombers during the Pearl Harbor attack. First hero of WWII, last name (**Dorie Miller**)
- 14 Discovered a pass through the Sierra Nevada mountains. The pass bears his name today, last name (**James Beckwourth**)
- 17 Leader of the slave ship Amistad revolt of 1839. It ended with the U.S. supreme court allowing the captives to return to African, first name (**Joseph Cinque**)
- 21 Rodeo star of African & Native American descent who created the art of Bulldogging where you race along beside the steer with your horse, jump from your horse grabbing the steer by the horns and wrestling him to the ground, last name (**Bill Pickett**)
- 22 Founder of the "North Star" anti-slavery newspaper, last name (**Frederick Douglass**)
- 24 First Black U.S. Army Chaplain, last name (**James Underdue**)
- 25 First person to reach the North Pole, last name (**Matthew Henson**)
- 26 Creator of the Red, Black & Green Afro American flag, last name (**Marcus Garvey**)

- 27 Leader of the Back to Africa movement of the early 20th century, first name (**Marcus Garvey**)

3. He planned the 1822 revolt against slavery that included some 9000 enslaved persons, last name (**Denmark Vesey**)
4. First former female slave to sue a white man in court for custody of her child, and win! first name (**Sojourner Truth**)
6. First African American to graduate from the U.S Military Academy at West Point in 1877, last name (**Henry Ossian Flipper**)
7. First African American to receive the Nobel Prize, first name (**Ralph Bunche**)
9. He became the spokesman for the Nation of Islam (**Malcolm X**)
- 11 Third African American to graduate from the U.S Military Academy at West Point, last name (**Charles Young**)
- 12 First principal of Tuskegee Institute, first name (**Booker T. Washington**)
- 15 The wife of Jean Baptiste Point DuSable (**Kittihawa**)
- 16 Last name of the person described in #1 down (**Tubman**)
- 18 The Black navigator who piloted one of Columbus' ships on his famous exposition to the "New World", last name (**Pedro Alonso Nino**)
19. The birth name of the person described in #4 down. She changed her name in 1843 after becoming a Christian, last name (**Isabelle Baumfree**)
20. First officer of the 10th Calvary, also known as the Buffalo Soldiers, middle name (**Henry Ossian Flipper**)
22. He was a founder of the Emanuel A.M.E. church in SC who was executed for a massive planned slave insurrection, first name (**Denmark Vesey**)
- 23 Mediator of the armistice which ended the 1948 Arab/Israeli war, last name (**Ralph Bunche**)
