Ann Lowe was an American couturier known for the distinctive evening wear and ball gowns she created for America's most prominent families between the 1920s and the 1960s.

While working on commission for Sonia Rosenberg in 1947, Lowe designed and created a blue-grey satin gown, featuring intricate beadwork and hand painted flowers.
