Patrick Kelly was a Paris-based American designer, known for his use of multicolored and monochromatic buttons on his garments. He intentionally arranged them in both geometric and abstract patterns as a nod to his grandmother.

In 1987, Kelly arranged gold buttons, in his signature heart shape, on a long sleeved black mini-dress. The look was originally shown as a part of his Fall/Winter 1987-88 collection, and was known as a "money dress," according to Kelly biographer Eric Darnell Pritchard.
