Climate Control

Our vans are designed for true 4-season comfort, keeping you at the perfect temperature no matter the weather. With wool insulation, an Espar heater that draws directly from the van's fuel tank, and ample ventilation, the space remains cozy in the winter and cool in the summer.

Climate Control Features

Espar gas or diesel heater mounted under passenger seat (controlled via thermostat)
Wool insulation throughout
Dual layer Reflectix insulation in ceiling ½" foam board insulation at Vanspeed Capsules to maximize space
Dual Maxxair roof fans with remote
Van Essential insulated window covers throughout

Storage

The van makes no sacrifices when it comes to keeping your gear organized. The under-bed garage offers over 40 square feet of storage—more than enough space to easily fit two bikes with the front tires removed. And if needed, the bed can be removed for those times where even more space is needed. Overhead shelves with a bin storage system maximize usable space while keeping weight distributed for stability. Additional drawer storage is seamlessly integrated under the couch and within the kitchenette, ensuring no valuable space is wasted.

Beds

Water Cabinet

A robust water system with enough water storage for drinking, dishes, and multiple days of showers, ensures you'll never be left dry on longer trips. The 12V hot water tank heats water efficiently, ensuring warm water is always available without draining the valuable power system. Grey water can be held or left open, adapting to your needs on the road. To prevent freezing in colder climates, all tanks and plumbing are mounted inside the van, ensuring operation no matter the weather.
