He was killed by unfaithful tenants in God's vineyard but has now reclaimed His inheritance. Every Lord's Day He continues to call us into His presence to pardon us, to teach us, to feed us, and then to send us back out into the world to make Him known. The end of Matthew's gospel is a new beginning for us. Will we do what He has told us?

## The Baptist Catechism: Q34

Q: How doth the spirit apply to us the redemption purchased by Christ?

A: The Spirit applieth to us the redemption purchased by Christ, by working faith in us (Eph. 1:13,14; John 6:37,39; Eph 2:8), and thereby uniting us to Christ, in our effectual calling (Eph. 3:17; 1 Cor. 1:9).
