## Keach's Catechism: Q. 65

Q. What is forbidden in the fourth commandment?  
A. The fourth commandment forbids the omission or careless performance of the duties required, (Ezek. 22:26; Amos 8:5; Mal. 1:13) and the profaning the day by idleness, (Acts 20:7, 9) or doing that which is in itself sinful, (Ezek. 23:38) or by unnecessary thoughts, words, or works, about worldly employments or recreations. (Isa. 58:13; Jer 17:24-27)

We practice Covenant Renewal Worship.

Call to Worship: God calls His people out of the world to gather in worship of Him.

Confession: God reminds us of our duty to Him and forgives us where we have sinned.

Consecration: God trains us for holiness and service through instruction by His Word.

Communion: God feeds us in order to strengthen us as we go back out into the world.

Commissioning: God gives us our mission as we depart.

At Trinity, we believe children are a gift from God, and we encourage families to see the importance of training them to participate in the worship service. It is an opportunity to learn the music, vocabulary, and rhythm of worship from young on. For those times that children are especially disruptive, we have a family/handicapped bathroom and kitchen that can both be used as a cry room, as well as a nursing room (mothers only) that can be used until they are ready to re-enter corporate worship.
