## Keach's Catechism: Q. 53

Q. What are we especially taught by these words before me, in the first commandment?

A. These words before me, in the first commandment teach us, that God, who seeth all things, taketh notice of and is much displeased with the sin of having any other god (Ex. 8:5, to the end).

We practice Covenant Renewal Worship.

Call to Worship: God calls His people out of the world to gather in worship of Him.

Confession: God reminds us of our duty to Him and forgives us where we have sinned.

Consecration: God trains us for holiness and service through instruction by His Word.

Communion: God feeds us in order to strengthen us as we go back out into the world.

Commissioning: God gives us our mission as we depart.
