Boaz is the Christ-figure that these destitute widows so badly need. He uses his character, his wealth, his position, and his strength to abundantly care for the woman who will become his bride. This is a story of hesed; of mercy, covenant faithfulness, and of God’s provision. We too may be tempted to find fulfillment in the fields of idolatry. Yet there is no blessing apart from the fields of the faithful God who supplies our every need. Therefore, walk in His fields, trust His provision, and delight in His mercy. At His right hand are pleasures forevermore (Ps. 16:11).

Q. 45. What did God at first reveal to man for the rule of his obedience?
