Baptist Catechism: Q. 79

Q: Which required in the eighth commandment?

A: The eighth commandment requires the lawful procuring and furthering the wealth and outward estate of ourselves and others. (Gen. 30:30; 47:14, 20; Ex. 23:4-5; Lev. 25:35; Deut. 22:1-5; 1 Tim. 5:8)

We practice Covenant Renewal Worship.

Call to Worship: God calls His people out of the world to gather in worship of Him.

Confession: God reminds us of our duty to Him and forgives us where we have sinned.

Consecration: God trains us for holiness and service through instruction by His Word.

Communion: God feeds us in order to strengthen us as we go back out into the world.

Commissioning: God gives us our mission as we depart.

At Trinity, we believe children are a gift from God, and we encourage families to see the importance of training them to participate in the worship service. It is an opportunity to learn the music, vocabulary, and rhythm of worship from young on.
