

THE CHARGE IS THIS

The controlling theme of Scripture and of world history is the glory of God. Because of the Fall, we have been blinded to God's glory and unable to find our way back. God answers this problem in the gospel; where He comes and does all the work of redemption. We have clearly seen that our Lord does not come finding people willing to cooperate; rather, He makes dead people willing by breathing the life of the gospel into them. The announcement that God saves sinners is summed up in the "Five Solas" which were emphasized in the evangelical reawakening at the Reformation. These words of life are discovered in Scripture alone (sola Scriptura), and reveal to us that we are saved by grace alone (sola gratia), through faith alone (sola fide), in Christ alone (solus Christus), for God's glory alone (soli Deo gloria).

New City Catechism Question #47

Q: Does the Lord's Supper add anything to Christ's atoning work?

A: No, Christ died once for all. The Lord's Supper is a covenant meal celebrating Christ's atoning work; as it is also a means of strengthening our faith as we look to him, and a foretaste of the future feast. But those who take part with unrepentant hearts eat and drink judgment on themselves.

Next Week's Text: Isaiah 46:8-10 - What is "Reformed"?

We practice Covenant Renewal Worship.

Call to Worship: God calls His people out of the world to gather in worship of Him.

Confession: God reminds us of our duty to Him and forgives us where we have sinned.

Consecration: God trains us for holiness and service through instruction by His Word.

Communion: God feeds us in order to strengthen us as we go back out into the world.

Commissioning: God gives us our mission as we depart.
