## THE CHARGE IS THIS

In the conclusion of the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus does not merely warn of the two paths of wise and foolish living. Jesus presents the only firm foundation that we can wisely build our lives upon that will stand on the day of judgement: his words. Those who believe in his words and who demonstrate that trust by doing what Jesus taught are the ones who have wisely built upon the solid rock of Christ. Believing and doing what Jesus taught is the only way that the righteousness necessary to enter the kingdom of heaven is to be gained. And when the flood of God's judgment comes it is only the righteousness found in Jesus that will allow us to withstand. So let us not be fools that build upon erroneous, unsound foundations. And we must warn others to not be fools as well. But take heart, for it is not by the authority of our own words that we will do this, but by the authority we have when we share Jesus' words.
