## New City Catechism Question #39

Q: With what attitude should we pray?

A: With love, perseverance, and gratefulness

## THE CHARGE IS THIS

In the story of Matthew 9:1-8, we learn that Jesus not only has authority over the natural realm, not only authority over the supernatural realm, but he has the authority to forgive sin. And in this story of healing we saw that there were several ironic twists that point us to the truth and to where our priorities ought to be. This paralyzed man was brought to Jesus in faith that he would be healed, and Jesus did indeed heal him, but first of his greater need then of his lesser need. Then, the scribes accused Jesus of blasphemy because he declared something that only God has the authority to declare, yet little did they know, they were looking at God in flesh. Lastly, even though it is easier to merely say that your sins are forgiveness the deeper reality is that, even compared to making the paralyzed walk, forgiveness of sin is the greater miracle. So remember that when we ask God to heal those we love and to perform miracles in our lives, that the greatest miracle we can pray for and celebrate is the forgiveness of sin by a holy God.
