CREATE YOUR OWN UNIQUE WEDDING DECOR

Paintbox Blooms offers a DIY and A La Carte wedding flower service.

Everyone has different needs so you can easily tailor your wedding flowers by choosing from bridal bouquets, to buttonholes, vases and flower filled arranger buckets of flowers.

How it works:

You decide what you need for your wedding. Take a look at the list below to guide you. A booking form including signed Ts and Cs and 10% deposit (non-refundable) of the final total will need to be transferred to secure your wedding flowers.

Flowers are typically collection only from East Chase Farm approx 24-48 hours before the wedding. In some special cases of large orders I can deliver to your home address or venue for an extra charge. Please ask for a quote.

Guidance of how to care for your flowers are given to each customer.

Wedding service is only available between April and October.

Embrace the magic of your wedding day with our exquisite bridal bouquets. Crafted to perfection, each bouquet is a unique blend of beauty and elegance, designed to reflect your style and the British seasons.

As an outdoor grower, I work with nature's rhythms, so flowers bloom in their own time-but that only adds to the variety and possibilities, ensuring each arrangement is special and seasonal.

As the flowers change week to week and bloom differently year to year, no bouquet is ever the same, making every wedding one-of-a-kind.

Your bridal bouquet will be thoughtfully designed to reflect your style and personality making it truly personal to you.

Bridal bouquets are finished simply with twine and packaged in a vase and vase box for transportation.

Bridal Bouquet FAQs

What will my Bridal bouquet look like?

My design style is typically 'Hand-tied' and/or 'Transverse'. Both bouquets are made to sit comfortably in your hands and are beautiful all the way round. A hand-tied bouquet is a more round shape but still in a loose, natural style. A transverse bouquet is shaped to sit more across the body but also looks beautiful all the way round. You are welcome send me photos of what you like to make sure we are a good fit. If you choose a 'Colour Consultation' I will also create an inspiration mood board.

What sizes are the Bridal, Bridesmaid and Posies?

The main body of the Bride's bouquet are 25-30cm with some flowers/foilage overspilling to create a whimsical, English country garden style bouquet. Bridesmaids bouquets are a smaller version that quietly compliments the Bridal bouquet. Posies are typically for flower girls however they can be an option for bridesmaids too. They are petite in size and are designed for children in mind. If you would like to discuss larger size options then please email me with your request to get an accurate quote.

What flowers will be included?

I follow the natural British growing calendar and flowers will bloom when they want to bloom. However I grow a wide range of flowers - there are so many to choose from, many you have never heard of! There is more to wedding flowers that Roses and Eucalyptus! Please see my handy flower guide below for what's in season.

BUTTONHOLES

Buttonholes designed to compliment and coordinate with bridal and bridesmaids bouquets.

Traditionally the groom and groomsmen wear a boutonniere on the left hand side lapel. A single flower or cluster of florals tied together to create a beautiful flourish. A lovely way to distinguish the bridal party.

Buttonholes are designed with stunning florals and fragrant herbs as mini bouquets in your chosen colour palette.

You can also of course DIY this yourself with our DIY buckets of flowers.

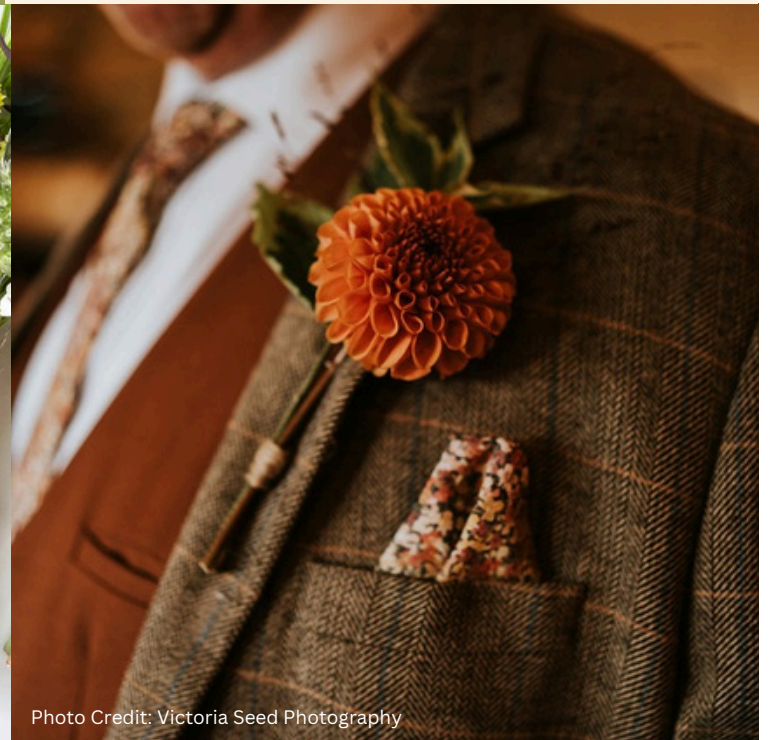

DIY BUCKETS OF FLOWERS

Arranger buckets of flowers are tailored for elopements, smaller weddings, those needing affordable options, or for those wanting to craft their own love story with DIY wedding flowers.

These options offer beautiful seasonal flowers in your chosen colour scheme and style. Flowers are grown by myself at East Chase Farm or if other flowers are required locally/British flowers will be sourced.

Need help with arrangement? An A La carte menu of floral options including: bouquets, bridal party flowers, vase arrangements, and DIY buckets allows you to mix and match for your floral needs. Available to collect from the farm studio or in some circumstances delivered to your chosen venue for an extra charge.

Real Wedding

CLASSIC SEPTEMBER WEDDING

Allie and Tom's wedding was at the beginning of September. The ceremony was held at Compton Verney and the reception at Wildflower Events Field at East Chase Farm, next to the field where I grow my flowers.

Allie asked for 1 bridal bouquet, 1 buttonhole and 3 buckets of flowers in a blue and white theme.

Each Bride's bouquet comes in a vase and box. Bridesmaid, button holes etc are packaged in jars and boxes. Please note bouquets and buttonholes are tied with twine only. You will need to purchase your own ribbon to tie on yourself if you wish.

With Allie's DIY buckets of flowers she made approx 30 bud vases plus there was enough flowers for one small jar arrangement next to the welcome table.

Bud vases can easily be bought online. Approx 3-4 stems is enough to fill 1 bud vase.

WHMISICAL JULY WEDDING

Gemma and Luke's wedding was in the mid-July 2024. Gemma asked for a colourful, whimsical, wildflower bouquet and florals.

Gemma and Luke requested a bridal bouquet, two bridesmaid, seven buttonholes and buckets of flowers to create jam jar table decorations.

With sustainability at the heart of their wedding, it was only natural that their wedding flowers were British grown.

I advise that 10-15 stems are needed for a standard size jam jar to look full enough.

Therefore one bucket of flowers would fill approx 4-5 jam jars.

Buckets of flowers are carefully curated and matched to your bouquets, buttonholes and any other floral decor.

Seasonal Flowers

Below an example of flowers for each season.

Early Spring: Narcissus, Tulips, Ranunculus, Blossom.

Late Spring: Aquilegia, Agrostemma, Sweet Rocket, Poppies

Early Summer: Roses, Larkspur, Nigella, Cornflower, Malope

Late Summer: Dahlias, Cosmos, Scabious, Sunflowers

Early Autumn: Dahlia, Phlox, Strawflowers, Cosmos

Late Autumn: Dahlia, Cosmos, Chrysanthemum, Rudbeckia

These are a limited example of flowers I grow across the seasons-there are many more!

My flowers are grown right here in Warwickshire, nurtured by the seasons and picked at their very best.

The blooms are naturally in tune with the rhythms of the British countryside. Picked fresh, often scented or fragrant and have a charm you simply don't get from mass-produced flowers.

I sow, grow and cut thousands of stems from my cut flower field between April and October. From the fancy Daffodils in Spring to the boldly beautiful Dahlias in Autumn,

My flowers are cut and sold for both retail and wholesale for florists, providing a wide range of high quality, sustainable flowers for people to enjoy.

By choosing seasonal flowers, you're not only getting the best of what nature has to offer, but you're also supporting sustainable, eco-friendly growing practices.

Please note these items are priced per arrangement with collection intended. Delivery in some circumstances can be made however a delivery charge would incur. Delivery charge is based on milage plus time to deliver florals and any set up needed. These are priced individually depending on distance and flowers ordered.

Why Choose Us?

All my flowers are grown with care and love without the use of chemicals. Each bouquet and arrangement is unique to the customer, carefully hand crafted with nature's beauty at the heart of every arrangement.

Locally grown, seasonal blooms capture a moment in time. No season is quite the same, giving a variety of flowers from week to week, making your wedding flowers completely unique.

Follow me on Instagram and Facebook to literally watch your flowers grow. I document how they start from a small seed and bloom into a beautifully scented flower. This also gives you an idea of varieties of flowers and when they most likely available.

Sustainability is an important ethos of Paintbox Blooms. No chemicals, no air miles, just flowers.

If you would like to discuss colour schemes further then you can book a face to face colour consultation at an extra cost. Please see services below.

There are two different services:

'Growers Choice' The client is to choose one of the following colour schemes: Soft Pastels, Bold Brights and Simple White. The floral selection will be 'grower's choice' and is a selection of what is looking great and in peak condition for cutting at the time of your event. You can be more a little more specific e.g pink and white. There is no additional cost to this service. Just drop me an email or phone call for a chat. You do need to know your colour scheme before contacting. I can then advise you on availability.

'Consultation Colour Service' The floral selection that will be in season at Paintbox Blooms is discussed together at my studio and I will take you on a tour of the flower field. I will share with you colour schemes and flowers plus what will be in peak season for the time of your event. Please note I cannot guarantee a particular type of flower due to growing outside. This service comes at an additional charge of £30 for an hour session.

You can speak to me in person on Fridays at my studio at East Chase Farm between 3pm and 4:30pm. Please message me beforehand. Or contact me by telephone on 07557145216 or email contact @paintboxblooms.com.

Samples or meetings in the flower farm field are not a component of our DIY Weddings or floral buckets unless you opt for a Consultation Colour Service charge at £30 for one hour. Posy jar of flowers included for you to take home.

Please note this is a DIY and A La Carte service and not a full floral service. If you require anything further, a wedding and event florist may be more suited for you.
