

# Gel Blaster Arena: Flora and Fauna Safety Policy

---

This document outlines the flora and fauna safety policy for Gel Blaster Arena. It provides guidelines for members to ensure they respect and protect the natural environment while participating in activities. The policy also highlights the importance of safety and awareness regarding the local wildlife and plant life.

## 1. Respect for Fauna
