Gel Blaster Arena: Medical Support Plan

This document outlines the medical support plan for Gel Blaster Arena, ensuring the safety and well-being of all participants. First aid and emergency medical procedures are detailed to provide clear guidelines for handling medical incidents.

1. Onsite Medical Support

Gel Blaster Arena provides onsite medical support through a registered nurse and a combat medic. They are trained to offer first aid triage and manage minor injuries promptly.

First Aid Triage

The onsite registered nurse and combat medic will perform the following first aid triage procedures:

- Assess and stabilize minor injuries.
- Provide basic wound care, including cleaning and dressing of wounds.
- Administer basic first aid treatments, such as bandaging and splinting.
- Monitor vital signs and assess the need for further medical intervention.

2. Handling Medical Emergencies

In the event of a medical emergency, the following steps will be taken to ensure the individual receives the necessary care:

Emergency First Aid

- Immediate first aid will be rendered by the onsite registered nurse and combat medic.
- The patient will be stabilized to the best of the onsite team's ability.

Evacuation Procedures

If further medical attention is required, the patient will be evacuated to the nearest emergency room. The nearest emergency rooms are located at Tully and Babinda, approximately 30 km away.

- Transportation will be arranged to transfer the patient to the nearest emergency room.
- If the situation is critical and requires faster transportation, an air lift can be mediated at the aerodrome, located approximately 1 km away from the arena.

3. Communication and Coordination

Effective communication and coordination are essential during medical emergencies. The following protocols will be followed:

- The onsite medical team will communicate with local emergency services to provide detailed information about the patient's condition.
- Coordination with the nearest hospitals (Tully and Babinda) will be established to prepare for the patient's arrival
- In case of air lift, communication with the aerodrome and air ambulance services will be maintained to ensure timely evacuation.

4. Equipment and Supplies

Gel Blaster Arena ensures that the onsite medical team is equipped with necessary first aid supplies and equipment to handle medical emergencies. This includes:

- First aid kits with bandages, antiseptics, splints, and other essential supplies.
- Medical equipment such as blood pressure monitors, stethoscopes, and thermometers.
- Emergency medical devices like automated external defibrillators (AEDs).

5. Training and Preparedness

The onsite medical team undergoes regular training to stay updated on first aid and emergency response procedures. This includes:

- Regular drills and simulations to practice emergency response.
- Continuous education on the latest first aid techniques and medical protocols.
- Coordination with local emergency services for joint training sessions.
